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Relativity is the Why

Everyone has seen the poster. It depicts the galaxy, or maybe the whole of the universe, and has an arrow pointing to the tiniest possible speck that it can refer to, and says: “You are here.” This teaching, actually taught to me in an undergrad philosophy course, is meant to make you feel insignificant and meaningless. The irony is that the scale IS the significance, the matter the WHY it *matters*.

Don't make the absolutist mistake of the materialist, and the egoist, and even the adherents of most religions, of believing that you're some standalone speck, separable from everything and everyone else, and that there is no meaning, no purpose, no reason. For the aforementioned poster actually demonstrates WHY the One was motivated to make Itself into the basis for infinite relativity of Itself.

Spacetime and matter make One Thing into Infinite Things.

Relative to any isolated mass within spacetime, to any incarnation of energy into matter, the mass is *everything*. Your existence is everything to *you*, for it can be no other. Everyone's existence is total for *them*. This is the reason WHY you are: so that the one force of energy that made Itself spacetime and matter can be infinite forms of Itself. Every amassment and every moment is perfectly unique, total, immeasurable and inimitable, always unrepeatably. This is why time, matter and mortality: RELATIVITY OF ONE.

Know Thyself

The most difficult thing to know in life is one's truest self and irreducible nature, for such is like the invisible and immeasurable alighting upon the perfectly open, radically-receiving palm, and as soon as one thinks that one sees it, or tries to define or contain it in one's grip, it gets pressed between one's fingers, awaiting the next state of grace.

For it's only when the self fades from mind that we enter into The Truth, that we are of and within God. This is what it is to be 'born again;' to find the truth of where and what we've always been when everything we were told that we are and thought that we are dissolves, the boundary that we set between the self that we imagine to be a single thing and the Self that's Everything falling, waking us to where and what we are: *an embodiment of the Everything*.

This is also the hidden, mystical mandate of Christianity concealed by its imperial, idolatrous, religious corruption:

To become a 'son of the Father,' to be 'reborn' into the Living Truth, to become *as* Christ, awakened to the hidden Base of Being upon which all beings stand; to become aware of being as a facet of Being, a form of formless God.

Where the eternal energy of the One, God, is embodied into matter, *Nature*, only there do you find your true Self.

Where the self, *ego*, is present, the true Self disappears.

The Prism

What do you see when you peer into the eyes of an other?

I see non-otherness peering through otherness at another form of Itself. I see indistinction looking through relative distinction at a formed self of Its formless selflessness.

It's for this reason that I've written:

When I look into your eyes, I see my Self looking back.

And it's the same for all Truth entering through the heart from the One Source. Indeed, it's true of the emanation and realization and specific formation of all things. That is, there's a pure Source, God, Truth, which wordlessly utters Itself, the Truth, through the heart, the eternal gateway of energy into matter. Our reception of the Truth is our sense, or *feeling*, of Truth, thence worded into relative truth.

The purity of the Truth's emanation into thought, the ability to decipher and word It, dictates the relative purity of its expression. This is why Taoism teaches that those who speak of the Tao don't know it, for as soon as you put Truth into the words of truth and try to grasp it, the Truth is made less than it is, and cannot be grasped, the fullness that makes it the Truth squeezed between the fingers. All such grasped truth is the Truth relative to the purity of its reception and the perfection of these imperfect words.

Thus is all truth uttered relative to the unutterable Truth of its derivation, and does all truth piggyback upon the Truth that gave it birth. In this we may glimpse the truth and birth of ourselves and all things, all truth formed relative to the Truth that's the all-pervading Source of *all* of its forms.

The quality, or veracity, or *truthfulness*, of all received Truth emanating into worded thought and spoken truth is always relative to the Truth of its origin. This relativity of truth is, in turn, always relative to the universality of its application. Only what's true for everything and everyone is of the all-pervasive, universal nature of eternal Truth.

So it is that the practice of spiritual but not religious theology, where philosophy meets the detection and deduction of the mystic and theosophist, and the induction into the words of the philosopher-poet, is the practice of meditating upon the pure white light, the Source of Truth.

We 'pagan priests and priestesses' need no religious specificity to receive and word what's *beyond* specifics.

And so it is that the practice of receiving the Truth and thinking and relating it into relative truth is akin to the pure white light of Holy Truth shining through an infinitely-faceted prism, of which we're one of the infinite facets. Thus we clean and polish our formed facet; we fortify our health, safeguard our vitality and practice purging our psychic blockage so as to project the perfectly pure light of Truth into the truth as purely as our personage will permit.

Ultimate Indistinction

The Ego's Reduction of Reality

Spacetime and matter mark the means of the RELATIVE distinction and location of indistinct, omnipresent energy. They are the HOW of The One becoming The Infinite. Never do they represent any absolute truth or identity, for they're impermanent, the relative truths within the absolute Truth, the impermanent forms of the permanently formless, the Infinite of The One. To confuse the mechanisms by which the Everything becomes anything with the Everything Itself is to believe that the reflection is the Source of what's being reflected; to believe the moon shines absent the Sun.

It gets tricky when the instinct, the sense, the *feeling* is truer than the thought that's limited to words. How to express a truth, to claim to have captured understanding, when not only dependent upon the words held in mind, but when the misleading 'rationalism' of modernity equates the ability to define and classify with the truth, and dismisses everything *felt* as containing no truth? By many a 'realist' dependent upon the modern philosophical paradigm of materialism have I been assured that my feelings don't matter, that matter is the basis of mind and thought, that everything came from nothing and that all

things within the cold, uncaring universe are accidental. In a former discussion group that I once attended, one such self-labeled 'realist' actually said to me: "We don't care about how you *feel*, Nick, we're only interested in sharp minds." By that he meant: *Sense is irrelevant*. What he was really saying: *My ego has no use for what can't be claimed*.

If it can't be possessed, if it can't be owned and controlled and used to grow the girth of the ego, of what worth is it? This is *especially* true in the globalizing capitalistic modern world wherein all self-worth is dependent upon the size of the ego and the bank account, upon all those things which we measure and attempt to control that grow up and around and occlude truth. For what we *sense* is actually the first, most direct connection to anything we come to *think*. We only try to measure what we sense is there, the difference between what's sensed and what's measured constituting the capacity of the technology to translate sense into truth. And so it is that what's *felt* is the origin of knowing, and what's *thought* always piggybacks upon what led us to the thought in the first place. The 'realist' simply has a limited notion of how knowing is conveyed, because they have a limited notion of what constitutes 'reality.' We grope for words in order to satisfy our egos with claims to understanding, with the realist and scientist affirming *measurable* reality, all while belying Oscar Wilde's greatest truism of all time: *To define is to limit*.

For anything to be definable it must fit within the limits of definition. For anything to be scientifically true it must be

measurable, and reducible to a classifiable, standalone identity. This is akin to defining a vehicle based upon its mechanistic constituents, to measuring every force that it harnesses, failing to realize that its purpose is to be a conveyance. You can define the human body the same way, also failing to realize that *it's a conveyance*. The *greatest* truth of the human body is precisely that: the evolution of matter through Nature in *conveying* Spirit. This is the same reason that *everything* exists, for that matter (literally): *To convey God; to disseminate Spirit*.

Does the fact that your sense isn't conveying the same truth to you, or that it *is* being conveyed and your ego is blocking it, and that it can't be perfectly defined, and that your scientific instrumentation can't measure it, *yet*, and is yet to 'objectively prove it as real,' necessarily make it *unreal*? I mean, what's truer of the history of science than that it's constantly disproving what it 'proved' before, always uncovering new connections that gradually wipe away its once separating measures, like a shoreline slowly eroding in the endless tide, returning to the Sea of Source, and that the ultimate, ironic purpose of science is to prove the divinity that it *thought* it was disproving as silly sense?

To *feel* a truth, to sense that the body is the conveyance, is to have a sense of the greater truth of *purpose*; to sense what's derided and dismissed as 'mere feeling' what's actually our direct link to everything we say that we 'know.' For what's *feeling* but sensory data, whether internally or externally derived? And what's *instinct*, or

intuition, but having a sense of some truth without being certain *how* that truth was perceived, and from *where* that perception was derived? Like all the greatest truth, it's *dislocated*. And what, then, could be more foolish, more irrational, arrogant and ignorant, than to dismiss all such means of knowing, and insist that truth must be *located*?

To call a truth untrue because you can't grasp it, you can't cage and control it within spacetime location, or within any measurable embodiment of energy, is to dismiss God Itself. If all understanding, meaning and value are predicated upon being able to absolutely or 'objectively' define, measure and control what's said to be known, what of every truth defying definition and beyond all means of measure? In reflection of an error in logic common to most logisticians and 'rationalists,' just because I can't prove to you that I know something doesn't *necessarily* mean that I don't know it, it simply means that I can't make my means of knowing perfectly align with your means of knowing.

If you require that 'reality' means that my means of knowing perfectly fit *your* means of knowing, it doesn't make you an absolute arbiter of what constitutes reality, it makes you someone with the insecure need to pretend to know by restricting 'knowledge' to a confined space, and pretending that everything outside that box is unreal. So it is that the very root of knowledge, where truth first touches human consciousness, and is called feeling, sense, instinct, intuition or the like, is belittled and treated with an arrogant disdain and disregard, even as it's precisely

this which informs the rationalist, realist and scientist what to think and where to look for the making of its measures. This is to ignore the very root of knowing; to pretend like that which grows up from it isn't connected to everything else that grows from it; that there's only trees, no forest.

If it can't be defined, and if the instrumentation and subsequent analysis of the measures of those instruments don't produce a clear, claimable 'objective truth,' then it must *not* be true, or so the logical error underlying all 'truth' claimed by science and realism goes. Is it any wonder that those, like me, whom, through experience, find that the *sense*, and the *instinctive access to the everlasting*, is truer than how we word it, become befuddled by a society that trashes all such knowledge? Try to convince anyone that's fallen in love that there's anything in the realm of mind, any perfect assortment of words, that perfectly defines and captures that love, or that we can control love with *reason*! I can hear God laugh.

The good news, fellow feelers: *The realist reality is wrong*. For if "to define is to limit," as Oscar Wilde teaches, then that which is limitless must forever defy definition. If God uses spacetime and matter to distinguish Itself, but can never be contained to these means of Self-expression, how can we ever point to anything, any measure, any amassment of energy into matter, and any relative distinction of any amassment from any other amassment and say: *look, I found God!*? How are they unable to see that being able to do this would undermine the very Base

of Being, and would be antithetical to what God is, much as religion pretends that God is something specific, and that the ability to translate God is in any way exclusive? Suffering from the egotism endemic to a world obsessed with control and greed, identity and power, there's nothing for the realist to gain from anything that can't be corralled.

What's the purpose of worshipping our sense of self if that self can't even claim to *be* a standalone self, and gather everything to itself that makes it appear bigger and better? And yet I'm here to tell you that the befuddlement that comes with being taught that reality is definable becomes revelatory when you're firmly set upon the Base of Being, and realize that you're at one with God, existing within and as a formation of the pure energy field of Universal Consciousness that individualized consciousness conducts.

That is, when you know that you're *inside* of God, not only inseparable from God, but a form of Its formlessness, the confusion is washed away, and all of life becomes an open, wonderous dialogue with God! The most aware, those most living within the unseen reality all around us, know that every 'truth' is relative to The Truth that is God, the one absolute truth, conveyed by everything, all of the time. Like God, the greatest truth, any truth approaching the one absolute truth, is known through immeasurable means, being divinely undefinable. For, being within, of and as a form of the Formless One, it dawns upon the sixth-sensing, third-eye-sighted, upon all those natural mystics, that they *always* knew, in their hearts, that the

greatest knowledge can never be claimed *because it defies definition and is beyond measurement*. Ultimately, truth is obtained relative to the *ego*. Like *gnosis*, the ultimate knowing, like The Tao, the Way that can't be accurately confined or named, because it's within all things and is only named in form, the greatest truths are granted when the controlling, possessing, limiting 'self' lets go of itself, its grasp unclenched, God alighting upon the open palm that, before this, squeezed the truth between the fingers of its grasping hand, eluding every form of the possessing grip.

Everything conveys the truth of God, because everything comes from and exists *within* God. You must realign your mind and perceptive capacity with this truth, at which point, when you see that there is no absolute distinction, no true separation between you and God and *anything*, you'll begin to hone your sense and instinct around this eternal, divine communique. Thus is all sensory capacity ultimately a perception of the divine essence and origin of everything and everyone, all the time. There's no limit to the means and magnitude of God's conveyance of Itself, i.e. *The Truth*. Everything is a sign and a signal pointing to its ultimate indistinction with 'everything else,' for there's ultimately no 'everything else,' only endless reformations of what always has been and always will be. *Otherness is an illusion*. For THAT'S what God is: *Ultimate Indistinction*.

Alas, deprived of this truth, burying it under propagandist lies so as to divide and control humanity, the religiosity inherent to the history of Empire and its evolving

adaptation to the pushback of progressive champions has stolen this truth from us, to our *drastically* detrimental disempowerment. Knowing and harnessing this buried truth, we become unified and empowered to combat the evils of divide and conquer that have long ruled humanity. And so the ego sickness, the belief and investment and defense and accruing of possession and money for the illusively-perceived, perpetually-deluded absolute self, is *everywhere* in most modern day societies. This sickness is, of course, a direct result of the natural, unifying, inclusive altar of God being replaced with the artificial, divisive, exclusive altar of egotism and greed manufactured by the plundering profiteers worshipping the devilish division to which most people pray. The Devil adorning robes of righteousness is exactly how spirituality became *religion*.

The more that a person moves towards and lives within their minds as any type of distinct identity, or *ego*, the more they move away from the indistinction of non-identity that's innate to The One that's the Everything. So it is that the sickness of ego is cured, or at least *treated*, through the eternal truth of divinity absent religiosity. For religion narrows and controls the all-encompassing in ways in which God's encompassment is constricted, and, thus, every religion portrays God in narrowing ways which *aren't truly of God*. Specificity of Spirit is impossible in any absolute sense, but should be celebrated in *relative* sense, in the infinite specific manifestations of the universal One.

Only the formations of the eternal energy field are specific, *us*, so that God may know limitless unique experiences of existence *through life*. Eternally does divinity dwell within the common heart of humanity, offering 'his' healing. This is the scale between spiritual sickness, i.e. egotism, and its cure, the move towards egolessness that no one may ever perfectly reach, but the quest of which enriches and brings us together in the invaluable rewards of love, the *sense* of our ultimate indistinction with every form of the formless. For what can be more *real*, and yet more beyond definition and measurement, and more *true*, than love itself? And what, then, proves itself to be more of God than love? This truth is only cause for distress by the 'realist' need to appease the ego by pretending that truth depends upon some limited, measurable proof, even as the realist himself would never actually want to live a life where love *can* be defined and controlled, where God can be lassoed and corralled, and claimed as possessed like some prized pony.

The mystic knows that the truth is always there because they live *within* Truth, and It's *always* expressing Itself; always pointing to Itself, everything a sign and symbol. The mystic thus knows that they're like mirrors of Truth, always reflecting It, never being the source of It. The mystic knows that his knowing is greatest when it falls upon that which refuses to acknowledge his attempts to describe it accurately, much less define it absolutely, or 'objectively,' in the parlance of the scientist. The mystic knows that everything wonderful and best about life is only such *because* it slips past every fence, that it circumvents every

gatekeeper, that it's power and truth are inversely commensurate with its ability to be certainly grasped. To know without knowing why or how, to be able to point at it without confusing it for the pointing finger, to reach for it but never to grasp it, only to allow it to sit upon the open, radically-accepting, receiving palm without gripping it, to hold only in energetic heart what the mind mars with words, to laugh at every claimed knowing and defining of 'reality' as squeezing the greater truth out between the fingers of their clenched fist. Such is the fuller, greater, wonderous loving of God. Thus may we find ourselves consistently overwhelmed with gratitude for the endless specificity this existence permits for the perfectly general, God celebrating the diversification of Itself through infinity.

Why God Chose THIS

Science and Religion Make the Same Mistake

God is the permanent within the impermanent, the inseparable within the separable, the formless within the form, the immeasurable within the measurable, the unlimited and undefinable within the limitations set by definition, the One Self peering through infinite selves.

Nothing comes from nothing. Everything comes from, exists within, and exists AS a form of the Everything.

Both Religion and Science make the same mistake, and thereby set themselves antithetically apart from true, discerning spirituality, the truths of which are reachable *philosophically*. Religion and science assert that divisions, classifications and identities, that is, separable essences, are the basis of existence. Yet, it's a prime principle of existence that *separation is an illusion*. No two atoms in the universe can be separated. All life is interdependently, intimately intertwined with all 'other' life, to the extent that 'otherness' is, itself, the great illusion; the dark magician tricking the scientists and the religious, and the symbolic 'dark lord of deception' known as the Devil, the 'great deceiver' whose prime deception is precisely that: that all those whom he wills to overrule possess their own

separated essence of being, the ego identity, or the 'soul.' It's *through* this belief in division that the Devil rules man.

This is the origin of all evil that, when taught religiously, became the 'Original Sin': teaching and perpetuating the false belief in separation; the belief that you have an independent, separate identity from everyone and everything else. In the *scientific* version of this prime mistake, everything is random and uncaring and came from nothing. In the religious version of the same mistake, everyone possesses a separable essence, or 'soul,' that's doomed to an eternity either in hellish torment or angelic ecstasy, or fighting for the release from this existential test, via reincarnation. These are entrapping, disempowering lies that conceal the core truth of being, representing mistakes of poor reasoning and logic which violate the inviolable prime principles of existence, the wording of which takes endless form, including 'nothing is created or destroyed, only forever rearranged,' with every such wording pointing to the indivisible Base of Being: GOD.

Nothing that is can come from something that isn't. Anything divided from or multiplied by zero is always zero. And reducing anything and everything as much as it can be reduced doesn't end in nothing, because nothing can be created or destroyed, and nothing comes from nothing, but must ultimately reach the point where further reduction is impossible. So what's the point where further reduction in the act of infinite reduction ends? At the point where it began! Everything. Of course, it never *truly* began,

and can't *actually* end, because it's beyond creation and destruction and every spacetime means by which the illusions of 'beginning' and 'ending' exist, as with the beginning and end of every form of life manifested from the formless. But if you start at the point where everything began relative to THIS existential construct, the Big Bang to the scientist, God for the religious, BOTH for me, and then explode this primal point of pure energy into everything there is, *then everything that is can only be that same everything, eternally rearranged*. And you can't remove anything from this everything, and, energetically, everything is *always* this everything, indistinct from everything else. So where does the distinction take hold? *It doesn't*. Distinction, separation, individuality... every form of and word applied to this core illusion only *appears* to take hold relative to us, to God's formations of Itself, via spacetime and matter, what The One, God, became by exploding 'himself' from one pure point of conscious being into the Infinite of One at the untouchable Base of Being.

There's no such thing as separating anyone or anything from their Source, whatever you call that Source, be it God, Spirit, The One, The Force, The Way... as Taoism teaches: *There is no one right name for the nameless One*. Teaching you that you're separate from the Source, that you exist as an entirely independent, standalone being, is the illusion that misleads a whole host of subsequently cascading delusions appealing to the illusive 'self,' or ego, and represents the Original Sin peddled by Empire and its religions. Because if you believe that you're divided from

God or any of Its manifestations, you're divided and conquered in your mind and all the actions your mind dictates, isolated and vulnerable, easy to control and profit off of, no longer a part of the holy family of God, all sons and daughters of the One, all permanently indistinct from everyone else with whom it's MOST natural to work together, as forms of one another, manifested from that which *knows no other, and is, indeed, incapable of otherness*. Heed Huxley: *All science is a reduction of multiplicity into identity*. In other words, all things can only be *relatively* (never absolutely) separated from all other things, via the Source becoming spacetime and matter. Everything there is exists as an accretion, or accumulation, of the One Thing that always has been and always will be.

The effect of this core truth of being is to create a duality for all forms of being. We are both the permanent and the impermanent within the same being, the matter made of the condensing, accumulating energy, the consciousness of the individualization conducting the One Consciousness, the spacetime object of the one subject that's never subject to spacetime, but that made Itself into spacetime and matter for the sake of an infinity of unique experiences of and within Itself. Thus do all of us carry God and the Devil within us at all times: the ability to follow unifying Source and the ability to follow dividing delusion. When we identify with the delusion of being an absolutely separate being, we follow the ego identity, and fall into the devilish trap of either the scientific or religious classification of being categorized and contained, whether

in a 'soul' or a taxonomy, thereby defining and limiting what's ultimately undefinable and limited only to Itself.

Both Science and Religion acquire power for themselves and their beneficiaries by concealing this holy truth of perfect inseparability. Both of these prevalent paradigms that believe that they're at war with one another for the right to claim ultimate truth are wrong, and actually act to *conceal* that ultimate truth: *You are a form of the Source.* That of you which exists forever is *always* there, within the part of you that doesn't. The essential is always the heart of the inessential, the permanent root forever regrowing impermanent fruits, timelessness hosting time. Why? *For the invaluable experience of eating endless forms of fruit, every bite taken by a unique being, in a unique moment.*

This form of existence exists BECAUSE of the inherent value of the experience of existence. We honor God by the gratitude of accepting and appreciating every *present*. Think about mortality versus immortality, and the One as a standalone being, God, and the Infinite of One as an endlessly varied multiplication of Itself. Do you not see, or at least sense, the divine reason why the Singular Self would choose to become Infinite of One? God manifests infinite forms of Its formlessness *through* Mother Nature, the realm of matter, the embodiment of its eternal energy. This holy union of energy and matter, in turn, procreated the basis for endless forms of existence; endlessly varying unique moments lived by an endless succession of forms evolving to fit their endlessly variant environments FOR

THE INNATE VALUE OF ENDLESSLY VARIANT BEING. Infinite perspectives upon existence, experienced by infinite forms, themselves perfectly unique, every experienced moment by every embodiment of The One thus perfectly unique, and invaluable TO each form BECAUSE they end; because every form is mortal, the perishing formations forever existing WITHIN and AS the unperishable essence of all being, what I sometimes refer to as the BASE OF BEING.

I've long consider myself a translator of the Source. So it was that, before I'd ever even *heard* of terms like 'non-duality' and 'monism' and 'pantheism,' concepts with roots penetrating *millennia* of human history, I called this idea 'monoexistentialism' as a young theologian in my twenties. I actually thought that I'd *created* the idea! How's that for youthful arrogance! Yet, I ultimately came to realize the nature of having 'stumbled upon' the non-dualist idea. I'm fascinated by the knowledge that I, and many other natural free thinkers, came to this realization *without any external teaching/training whatsoever*. I'd never even heard of it outside of myself; outside of a series of contemplations informed by heart, where the purely energetic One first finds 'his' foothold in material being, and where every 'prophet' is defined relative to the ability to most clearly heed, word and enact the wisdom of heart.

That is, I came to the timeless truth without ever being *told* it was so, wholly within myself, almost as an 'a priori' instinctive awareness affirmed by my contemplations. This is, of course, why many may, and ultimately *must*, come to

the same conclusions, endlessly uniquely worded. For all truth is *always* the truth. Like us, truth can't be created or destroyed, but is the perpetually reconstituted core. Like God, in whom the truth exists, the truth ALWAYS is, awaiting rediscovery by every form, glimpsed from infinite perspectives, always true RELATIVE to those perspectives. This also reveals a connected, disempowering lie of religion and the egotism of modernity in general: idolatry is antithetical to spiritual truth, for all may access the truth forever residing within the immanent and eternal in us all. That is: *While hearts beat, The Prophet continues to speak.*

So it is that we cannot be divided from God, rather, we are of and within God as mortal forms of God. Both Science and Religion have stolen this timeless, empowering, freeing, uniting truth from the people. We are holy people, holy beings, *all of us*, tricked by the dividers and conquerors into believing otherwise, put into the mental cages of illusive separability, becoming 'unholy' only to the extent where we believe the cage is real and where we follow the divisive identities that produce every form of evil, including tribalism, nationalism, and every other form of 'us versus them.' All holy men and women point to the divine unification *always* underlying every moment, as our most natural form of being, the indivisible essence of One.

When Presence is Pleasure is Purpose

In those moments of the purest presence, when the self has vacated the mind, we are both free and enlightened. For only in forgetting ourselves are we freed of ourselves, becoming what we most innately are, the truest, most natural self whom only emerges absent its awareness of itself, and all the ideas of itself which it's compelled to defend. Alas, as soon as we gaze upon our enlightenment it disappears into invisibility, like an eye that's blinded by the belief that there's a difference between the seer and the seen, between looking outward and looking inward, between the eternal energy of the most infinitesimal speck of all existence and any accrual of the specks of the Spirit.

I have this recurring, instinctive thought that God made Itself from pure, irreducible, indivisible conscious energy into spacetime and matter because 'he' is the greatest, most glorious of hedonists. The parallels between the spiritual master and the paragon of pleasure are quite remarkable, in fact. So much so that I'm inclined to remark upon them. Think of the parallels between practicing presence, attempting to sit in the eternity of now, releasing our divisible, egotistic ideas of ourselves and experiencing the purity of the present and the *hedonist* who gets a bad

rep because of his or her affinity for what religion and all the related, misleading modes of morality coerce us into believing are the 'lesser desires of our lower, base nature.' Thinking of how misunderstood this holy man may be, and how this overlaps with why this form of existence exists in the first place, I'm impelled to ask some critical questions.

Who's a godly person but one who's most often in a state of pure, appreciative adoration of what they're currently experiencing? Is not the reverent person he or she whom routinely reveres the perpetually priceless, uniquely-gifted experience of every moment *as* themselves, as a perfectly unique organism living their own special set of entirely inimitable moments, every moment and every perspective upon that moment never to occur again, to the precise same entity, in the precise same spacetime and mental state, observed from the same individualized position? What a motive for that which is all things to 'big bang' into the existential basis for an endless evolution of everything!

And when the connoisseur, the lover of this or that type and discerning, qualitative degree of experience, is fully *within* that experience, and is thereby practicing presence, through an endless multitude of potential means, through sex, through the intimate worship of every alluring woman as a unique incarnation of the Divine Feminine Incarnate, through the endless array of subtlety in the flavors of food and wine, through pure, quivering, overtaken observation, through noticing the peculiar particularities of the birds at the feeder, and through any and every other type of

experience which they exalt and romanticize and seek the ideal of, are they not demonstrating the very thankfulness, the very gratitude and height of observation and practicing of presence promoted by the sages? How is being full of the pleasure or pain of *any* moment *not* presence? How is the worship of all that may be contained in any one moment not the same as worshipping its Source? And what did God do by seeming to divide Itself from the One into Infinite of One but set the stage for endless forms of this very type of infinite inimitability, eternally extended?

Yes, we, especially the 'squares' amongst us, the obedient bourgeoisie, by our conditioning, may come to call some of these experiences, like praying or meditating, *holy*, and some of them *unholy*. For this we most certainly have the training received in morality and ethics and being a good Christian or a stalwart patriot or whatever other prejudicial perspective is unnaturally pressed upon our indoctrinated judgments to thank. But let me suggest that the one who practices lovemaking, and 'feasting with the eyes first,' and the palette sensitivity of the sommelier and epicurean, and the joy of cultivation and the appreciation of the first bite of the just picked strawberry, who often 'stops to smell the flowers,' and who pursues the peak of every other form of pleasure which we might reflexively judge as lustful or gluttonous, base or beastly by our good little boy and girl parameters, can be *just* as godly as the nun on her knees, dutifully praying to the cross in any official 'house of God.'

One might argue that the nun is the *least* holy of these practitioners, in fact, in any way in which her practices might induce her to 'look down upon others,' for example, and due to the fact that the epicurean and Casanova is *more* likely to be living in the present moment free from the manufactured guilt of the Empire that put her on her knees in order to control her through her doubt, fear, gullibility, need for acceptance and every other exploited weakness. The *true* holy man, on the other hand, *sees* the artificial cages into which others try to stuff him, including the professional priest, and that the 'house of God' is as much alive in any natural realm as within any church or temple, and arguably more so; whatever frees you from any notion that God is anywhere more specific than *everywhere*, and that Nature is any less than divine matter.

Ironically, the nun's salvation just might be as readily found in the bedroom of the right, mutually-worshipping lover as beneath the cross, her prayers answered in the enactment of love rather than the shame and guilt of denying that love may be found upon as many paths of pursuit as there are explorations of the holy realm that love represents. All of which is not to nihilistically claim that existence is free of morality, but to suggest that morality is ultimately about serving the highest quality of the experience of existence for as many forms of existence as possible, and that the hedonist and the sage may thereby serve the same master.

Relative to One

The Scale of Good and Evil

The nature of God can be the source of great consolation for us since he is pure oneness, being free of any accretive multiplicity of distinction even on a conceptual level, and since everything which is in him is God himself.

- Meister Eckhart

When we speak of the Devil with truth, we speak not of an entity, but of a relative force, or quality. The Devil is simply the personification of this force, or quality, made into the bogeyman of the relative capacity for good and evil innate to every human being. The same is true of God, except God is the antithetical force, as all things are born by and are known through and always exist inseparably from their opposite in the Yin-Yang balancing duality of all things. Some mistake the fact that this duality exists as being a contradiction of the non-dual Base of Being, forgetting, else never knowing, that the duality exists *within* the non-duality, all separation *relative to* inseparability. And in the duality of good and evil, God is unified being, the Base of Being, and the Devil is divided being, the appearance of an absolutely fractured foundation which actually *can't* crack.

The more that something unifies, the more of God it is, for God is the holy unity at the Base of Being; the eternal godly ground upon which we stand, and upon which all life in its endless multiplicity of this One Force evolves and develops. So it is that one approaches the Devil the more that they move away from God, the unified Base of Being. This is true both in relation to themselves, to every aspect of the self, including the health of the body and the force of one's ego, as well as in relation to everything 'outward' and 'other' that, ultimately, is a multiplication and evolving outgrowth of the immanent-most constituting everything. Relativity, in fact, is the crux upon which all truth hangs, as with science being, in Huxley's words, "the reduction of all multiplicity into (absolutely separable) identity," the One relatively divided through the material condensations and relative separations permitted by the spacetime to which It ultimately isn't subject, as the one irrelative force of Being.

And there isn't a single aspect of life, humanity, society or anything 'else' that isn't tied to and knowable through this one scale of good and evil, from indistinction to seemingly separable distinction. This is the One War at the heart of every war: unified being, felt as love and based upon the truest possible understanding, and divided being, felt as hate and misunderstood based upon the ignorant illusion of an absolute otherness that doesn't actually exist, but is merely the perception of a complete separation based upon the Source energy becoming spacetime and matter.

Science bows more and more to the non-dualism that sages have always sensed, and poets have always scribed. Religion bows more and more to the spiritual but not religious scholar that knows that *anyone* may speak the spiritual truth at any time, anywhere, tapping into Source, and that the idolatry of worshipping one prophet is a tool of Empire to control gullible, fearful minds, for, in truth, the prophets are those best putting to word and action the awareness in every heart. *All may thus be prophetic*. In the quest for power and control, both science and religion pretend to divide what can't be divided, and to exclude some parts of the Everything from all 'other' parts of Itself, representing one side of an equation always equaling One.

This is the constant Yin-Yang scale upon which everything may be weighed, including our relative dedication to non-duality and duality, to truth and delusion, and to good and evil. The non-dual Base of Being, the inseparable, unifying, essential, permanent force of existence vs. the separable, dividing, inessential, impermanent force of existence that is, itself, but the byproduct of One becoming Infinite of One. When we live our lives in our egos, as a deluded, absolutely separable 'self,' with or without the notion of possessing a soul separable from God and all of Its manifestations of life, and punished or 'saved' through the fantasy of an afterlife created to control us, and following the idolatrous delusion of 'one prophet' or one set of symbols or rituals, or one book, or any other such excluding, narrowing, dividing idea common to the errors of both science and religion, we act in service to the Devil.

When we act to divide and dissolve in thought, speech and action, both within ourselves, in our relative disunity of heart, body and mind, and without ourselves, in our relative disunity with all the life force of which we're actually inseparable, we've been ensnared by Satan. All false leaders build their power through Satan; demagogues like Trump who take and build their power and rule through every manner of divide and conquer; through individualism, one individual against another individual in identity and thought and action, all boundaries and 'mine versus yours,' all tribalism and nationalism, all the alienation and magnification of the sense of otherness, and any other force which unnaturally tears humanity into the seams through which the parasitic leeches suck the life force from the whole. All true leaders, the champions of God, are known relative to their *opposing* representation, their leadership based not upon divide and conquer, but upon unify and empower, not by forcing equality or sameness, but by empowering the whole in its endless diversity of the One forever reborn as Infinite of One. Thus 'the prophet' is but the heart most clearly conducted into mind, with as little intercedence from the ego as possible, inviting every form of the One into our holy indistinction.

Strengthening the whole by acting to the common, inclusive, symbiotic advantage of all is the work of God, weakening the whole by acting to separate, exclude and parasitically feed off of the defenseless aspect of the whole is the work of the Devil. Again, there isn't a single part of human existence that isn't tied to this universal principle.

And you can't know one side of the scale without knowing the other, for they're inseparable sides of the same force; polar opposites in the wavelengths of the energetic One. Always do the two sides exist relative to the other, always representing the all-pervading scale of relativity. And you can only really know the one side by moving away from it, which is why so many sages note the clarity of contrast. What's the night without the sun, the stars without the black void, sunny days without the bone-numbing nights?

Even within the seemingly standalone entity does this scale exist. The ego is the devilish delusion of absolutely separated, classifiable, definable being, the forever misleading identity, whilst egolessness is the godly truth of inseparable, unclassifiable, undefinable being, the forever guiding non-identity speaking through the immanent-most emergence of all things, most strongly felt in the heart, where the matter of body first receives the eternal flame. And, again, everything flows through this one core truth. For example: Health is the ability of the body to conduct the Spirit. This ability, in turn, exists relative to the efficiency and effortless interaction of the whole of what we divide into separable physiological systems which, when best conducting Spirit, are, *like* Spirit, so intertwined that separating them into parts becomes unnatural, akin to the dissolubility and disintegration hastening bodily death.

So it is that medicine, like everything else, may be set upon this same scale. Good healthcare strengthens the whole organism, representing the cohesion and protection of

holistic treatment, the guarding and cultivation of the essential life force, the synergism of everything, the all for one and one for all that decries divisibility and disproves distinction. Poor health is, on the other side of the scale, the dissolution of the whole due to insufficient protection, gluttonous over-gratification, symptom masking and unnaturally pretending like 'healthcare' is about isolating and independently treating different parts of the body and brain. Like all evil, it's divisive; divide and conquer relative to healthcare. All good naturopaths, on the other hand, as with all those acting within the 'food is medicine' paradigm of *true* wellness, know that you can't ever treat anything in isolation, for all parts of the body feed into one another, and while classifying the benefits of any medicine is helpful in terms of studying its most noticeable effect in relation to the whole, classification ultimately belies the synergistic basis of good health. Alas, dividing everything and masking symptoms and creating unnatural dependencies for the sake of weak, perpetually-paying patrons is the evil of 'western medicine,' Satan served as *profit over people*.

Thus are the temptations of the Devil always those lures of the ego and the body which please relative to the weakening and disintegration of the whole, that which gratifies relative to the reduction of total life, including the greed that feeds off of all disadvantage, and are the salvations of God always those instincts which fulfill relative to the strengthening and integration of the whole, that which heartens relative to the increase of total life.

So it is that what's deemed 'success,' and those deemed 'successful people,' in western, capitalist, globalizing society is based upon successfully plundering people and planet in producing the revenue, income, profit and equity ownership of 'financial success.' *It's all coming from somewhere. Nothing is taken from nothing.* Not a dollar of profit isn't paid for by people and planet. All greed is paid for by those and that from which it's exploitatively extracted, from financial greed feeding on disadvantage and the lack of protection and privilege of the people and the planet, to the body and quality of existence paying the price for drug addiction, alcoholism and gluttony, to the enlightened self paying the price for the misleading ego constantly defining and defending an absolutely separable, standalone 'self,' the unified Self paying for all tribalism and divisive identity. Unification to division, that's the scale of good and evil. And there's no theory, practice, action, not a single thought that isn't representative of God or the Devil based upon where it's set upon the scale measuring its total impact from perfect unification to perfect division.

The Devil's Advocate

Defense Advises Division and Denial

The Master of Evil came to me in a dream. He perceived that I loved to ponder, and, after hooking me with the lures of my appetites, and playing upon my egoistic identity as a philosopher, and supplicating himself before me, inquired:

How do you enslave the people, chaining them to your will, in service of self-glorying ego, without their resistance?

Well, if the people can see their chains, and know that they're in a cage, they will fight to free themselves. So it is that the slaveholders of the past couldn't hold onto their slaves, for the slaves knew that they were slaves, and were thus resolved to fight for their freedom. It's precisely the certainty of enslavement that inevitably ends enslavement. So enslavement must remain deniable. We must make people believe that slavery is over; a vestige of the past; something that has nothing to do with today. People must believe, must *know*, that they're free. That's the only way for their enslaved service to you to last: it must be *unreal*. So, we must control what reality means in people's minds.

So, what do you advise?

Make their enslavement invisible. Hide it behind wordplay, called propaganda. Hide it in the opposite ideas of what it actually is, and keep lying until the people believe it. Make

the chains into something else, something that seems freeing, but which is actually enslaving. Money. Credit. Wealth. Possession. Class. Ego. Glorify individualism, tribe and country. Make the whole compete against itself instead of cooperate, such that their weakness becomes your opportunity. Set yourself atop the pyramid served by money. And so all these things shall become the means of separation, the divisions conducive to conquering, the chains, bars and cages that they shall happily wrap around themselves, for they shall all accomplish the enslavement that you seek while forever denying its existence. Assign misleadings to all these means of enslavement. Call them anything but what they truly are. Call them the opposite, *freedom*, and they'll believe it. For if they can't see their chains, if they don't know that you've put them in the cage, then they shall be in Plato's Cave, having no reason to disbelieve the lies that you cast against the walls as real.

So I must enslave them without their knowing it...

Yes. And if you do it well enough, if, like obedient dogs, you make them forget their collars and leashes, then they shall do your bidding without knowing that anything is wrong. Well, they'll still know it in *heart*, but they won't know it in mind, for that shall be the success of this system: to divide heart from mind, man from God, truth from feeling, as though those separations are real. Own all knowledge, what the people shall call science and realism and materialism and conservatism, everything that separates and labels and divides every form from every other form of

God's multiplicity through Nature, and this false reality shall rule the mental sphere of people's existences, recrafting the bonds of slavery as forms of freedom. Make everything that denies the eternal brotherhood, that separates man from itself and God, that reveals the secret, universal heart, seem a naïve fantasy. Denigrate those that know it as *idealistic*. Make those that know the truth as not just wrong, but *mad*. Make it so that soothsayers are known to be delusional as soon as they speak. Make sanity itself defined by a person's acceptance of the insanity that most shall call the one and only reality. Then make the people fight against one another for your false form of freedom, forever hiding the fact that the fight *is* slavery, for if they cooperated instead of competed, only then would they be able to free themselves from your invisible pens. So befuddled, so *1984'd*, so twisted in mind shall they be, so conditioned by peer-pressuring conformity, that when they see their chains they shall see only forms of *freedom*.

*And what of those that see through the smokescreen?
What of those that realize that they're in cages, and that
fight to free themselves from bonds that they can still see?*

They shall be the slim minority. Because they don't believe what we train the people to believe, they will not be considered good, because good is what the masses and those of authority *say* that it is. We shall *dictate* good, and hide evil so well that serving you *becomes* the good, and so all who say otherwise shall be immediately condemned by the majority in the cages. For history is on our side, you

see. Communism was overcome, and socialism became a soft spot susceptible to tyrants. So now the people are easily convinced that the tyrants were socialists, and so socialism, the ideological gateway to true freedom, may be made to seem the opposite: the *closing* of the gateway.

So all those that come to free the people shall be seen as the opposite, as those seeking to trick the sane and good...

Yes. The emancipators shall be called the masters of deception. The evil-doers, those that best follow your example, shall be lionized, and made into princes and presidents. Parasitism shall rule. Cooperation, solidarity, inseparability, symbiosis, the spiritual power innate to everyone's innermost being, shall be forgotten; buried beneath the mass of mutual throat-cutting called 'free market economics.' Ego shall be glorified. The opposite of truth shall be the prevailing truth. Plutocracy will be called democracy, with oligarchs ruling behind 'representation.'

And the few who understand will be of no consequence, for, as Machiavelli taught long ago, the mass of people are easily misled, and believe what they're told, and are easy to train, for they lack sufficient doubt. They shall only see what they've been trained to see as reality. How shall the masses doubt the state, the ethos, the appearance, when you will write the important books, and when they lack the ability to see through the truths enforced as *propriety*? All must be *proper*, you see, by peer-pressuring decree. So doubt shall be discouraged as a *lack of faith*. And the seers shall be silenced behind the mindless mob of sheep living

their entire lives in their invisible pens, led as if to some glorious afterlife, the gates of which we shall control. And so we may shear and slaughter them at will, feeding upon un-lived lives secretly serving the *opposite* of their belief.

So, in the end, not only shall they be my slaves, shall they serve their own separation, and glorify their removal from God in their divided, conquered state, building walls between themselves and their brethren, but they'll thank me for it, and actively fight to stay in chains, and berate and condemn as unpatriotic and devilish and lacking faith those that come to free them, such that I may own them without their knowledge, and rule invisibly, as if I'm God.

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This is how I helped the Devil enslave the people. For I thought that it was merely an exercise; *only a dream*.

In the end he thanked me, and made me believe I was God's acolyte. Only when I awoke did I know why I was made to play the advocate for the Master of Evil, the same reason Yahweh was executed: *because the only way to know good is through the evil of advocating for the Devil*.

The Secret of the Sage

The Secret of the Sage is simple, but difficult to practice:

There is no self. The self is an illusion.

That is, the individual being, the absolute, standalone entity, that which exists in distinction of all other individual entities, doesn't actually exist. Instead, this is the core illusion propagating all delusion. In fact, separation itself is an illusion, for all separability is relative, never absolute.

For there is no separating anything that is from everything there is, and no separating the past from the present from the future, the first specks of Spirit blown out from the Big Bang from any 'other' which those source specks innately draw to themselves as the spiritual force of Self-attraction we call 'gravity,' as if the metaphysical fabric can be torn.

There's but one Self, and It's formless, immortal and beyond time. We are Its individualizations. There is no 'soul,' at least, again, not in the sense of an essence of being that can be separated from essential Being. The Being, the One, is all-inclusive. We're ones of the One.

There is but one Soul, the Self, the Spirit, the One, most commonly known as *God*. The metaphysical foundation isn't just unfractured, It's incapable of being divided from

any 'other' of Itself. There aren't essences thrown into hellish or ecstatic afterlives, but eternally remade Essence.

At the same time, material being permits the endless diversity of form, perspective and thought of individualism, the infinite variety of body and mind existing within, and as facets, of the One. Individuality is, in fact, the secret *why* hiding within the framework of spacetime and matter.

We, all forms of life, both on this planet and on all other planets harboring life, are the Infinite of the One. We allow for the formless One to take infinite form, always in adaptive, evolving response to the pressures, needs and constraints of the environments in which everyone exists.

The Great Mother is the womb receiving the eternal, sacred seed of energetic Being giving birth to every form of being. We allow immortality to experience the gift of mortality, for life is invaluable *because* it ends. We allow the perfectly ubiquitous, universal and general to experience being fixed, finite and formed. We are Its embodiments, Its endlessly remade receiving and conveying vessels, that which receives Its truths for relative translation, carrying It across the expanse of Its infinity.

The 'point' of spacetime and matter is the providence of One Being to be infinite of Itself. This existential construct imparts perfectly unique moments of experience for the inherent value of experience, which is the 'point' of experiencing existence. Through spacetime and matter the Universal One bequeathed Itself the ability to experience

endless unique moments, every being itself being a perfectly unique form of Being, every moment a perfectly unique, unrepeatably, inimitable experience. No two experiences are ever had the same way twice, however mundane they may seem, for they're always had by a unique being with a special viewpoint within a spacetime.

By the same principle no two forms of beauty are the same, no two joys or sorrows, pleasures or pains. Nothing that's experienced will ever be experienced exactly the same way by the same embodiment of Being ever again, the inherent value of those gifted 'presents' constituting 'the point.' For while we apply these words, beauty, joy, sorrow, pleasure and pain and the like, constantly, and in the general sense, the point of forming being from Being is that they're *never* generally experienced. So it is that mortality is a great gift, for it's precisely what provides for the invaluable nature of existence that's experienced as priceless and irreplaceable because it *is*, and because it ends.

This is why the One made Itself into the infinite by 'big banging' from Its point of pure energetic consciousness, the singularity at the heart of Its infinite plurality, into spacetime and matter. And while a common delusion of the illusion of individuality is that we're separate from God, and have separable souls, or, in the prevailing modern materialist/realist/atheist paradigm, that there's no God at all, and that this is the actual delusion, the truth is that there isn't a speck of the universe, not the slightest smidgen of anything, that's independent of the Everything.

The end of the act of infinite reduction isn't nothing, as though all existence is a product of zero, which makes no logical sense (atheism), for anything times zero is zero; nor is it divisible or specific, like definite swatches of separable fabric (religiosity), for anything times everything is always a product of everything, nor is it unknowable, except by the limiting definitions of measurement and language (agnosticism), but, by philosophical reasoning and logic, and the third eye instinct, sense and mysticism that modernity derides (but which is actually innate to 'knowing),' it's knowable as One. All hearts secretly know this, which is why we feel love; feeling love is feeling truth. So it is that the answer to the big why is that everything exists as is so that the Everything could endlessly experience Itself in a way that ends, that's perfectly unique in form and perspective of irreplaceable moments of existence before 'dying,' reemerging with the Source Self.

There's no after Everything. There's no beyond the Infinite. There's only forever remade forms of the formless One evolving to 'fit' and balance out all other fitting forms of Its eternal Self, all relative separation serving inseparability.

In the biological being, the heart is the gateway of energy into matter, the receiver of the divine spark of life, and holder of the eternal flame. This is why love is felt in the heart, because the heart represents the bridge between Being and being. Love is the feeling of utter indistinction.

This is why the training of the sage is the training of self-divestment, the opposite of egotism. For 'sentience' is the

entity sensing itself, being aware that a 'self' exists, and ego is the entity misconstruing this self-awareness innate to Being experiencing Itself as beings as the perception of an absolutely separate self, especially in the absence of instruction and practice in Self-awareness, an awareness that exists in equal opposition to the illusions of the self.

Everything is interbeing. Totality is interdependence, not a single string able to be removed from the metaphysical fabric, the ball being endlessly unstrung. The fabric doesn't need to be sown together, because it can't be torn in the first place. A forest isn't divisible trees, but an endlessly-assorted, indivisible network of living interchange, every being dependent upon the health of the whole, always exchanging, communicating and competing amongst its fused forms for the sustainable best of the whole.

So it is with us, environmentally and metaphysically. The One is all-encompassing, and isn't just greater than whatever sums we measure in Its parts, but is indistinct and dependent upon all parts of Itself, so much so that to assert that the whole has 'parts' is misleading. None may be apart. And all human discord, all the sickness sucked in by the ego, the deluded 'self,' is born of, and borne, exacerbated and perpetuated by, the absence of this Truth of the One. I'm one of the One, and everything that I do to any 'other' one I do to myself, as a fellow one of the One.

The separably singular self is vulnerable in body and mind, plagued by the traumas trapped in the psyche, sickened by the ceaseless self-defenses and covetous cutthroat

competitions of the illusory ego. The body suffers for the same fundamental reason as does the traumatized and deluded mind: relative to its false sense of separation from its Self, from the invulnerable, universal Source that it is.

Thus is the answer to human suffering the spiritual practice of releasing all sense of self from the mind, and fortifying the body against its own separations, the entropy of its eventual disintegration, that which we no longer need fear, for we understand that all disintegration is part of the process of eternal reintegration with the whole that we are. Good is unification, the return to Source Being. Evil is always division, the relative moving away from and sense of separability of being, ultimately becoming the worship of the self as though it's an absolute entity, and holding it up on the bent backs of all deluded 'others,' i.e. Satanism.

The practice of releasing and refusing to invest in and build up ideas of the separable self is the core spiritual practice because it reflects the fundamental truth of oneness at the Base of Being. Spiritual practice is nothing more or less than 'returning' to where and what you everlastingly are. This is the same as meditation, as releasing everything pertaining to the measured and defined 'self,' and dwelling in the immeasurability that's innate to Source Self. When we're 'in the now' we're in the meditative state, because the self is gone; there's only the selfless experience.

This, too, is the spiritual concept of surrendering, and Islam's meaning of submission: the ego self surrendering to the egoless Self, the submission *not* to manmade

authority, but to the innermost will of God, something which every form of faith can only interpret, never control.

And so I say: Do unto 'others' as you would do unto the Self that every form of Self essentially is. Serve the Self (God) by serving what's best for as many forms of Itself (demigods, aka 'lifeforms') as possible. The goal is to be oneself without having to invent and defend a defined self. Just be who and what you are, in every uniquely gifted moment. Just be your unique one of the Infinite One.

The Law of One

Physics is a Function of Metaphysics

The law of physics that states that “every action has an equal and opposite reaction” is actually a *metaphysical* law. This law is a natural effect of all things being One, thereby demonstrating the truth that *separation is an illusion*. In theological circles, this is known as the principle of ‘non-duality.’ We’re all embodiments of the One Source of all energy and matter, existing entirely within and inseparable from that Source, our bodies Its energy, our consciousness the conductor of the One Consciousness. So, while many a theologian posits the misleading notion that either a duality exists or it doesn’t, that either we exist *and* God exists (duality), else all things are *only* God (non-duality), this is the logical mistake of absolutism that reigns over all forms of evil, spurring egotism and tribalism of every order and being fundamental to the erroneous Christian conceptions of dividing God from man, man from man, the universal prophet in heart from those who speak that prophetic truth, the ability to conduct that truth falsely revered as the idolatry *antithetical* to true divinity.

As Alan Watts commented in *Become What You Are*, “in Christianity, God is essentially Other.” I call this the Original Sin: attempting to convince people that they’re separate from what they can never be separated from in order to

weaken, control and exploit them. It was *not*, I'll continue to argue, what Jesus *actually* believed, but was imposed upon his followers in the imperial edicts turning his spiritual philosophy into its religious corruption, for no awakened being, no *Christ*, would attempt to enforce a boundary that doesn't actually exist. So who, then, is right, the Christian insisting that there's a distinction between God and man, or the non-dualist theologian who says that everything is God? The answer, of course, is the same as the answers provided by physics secretly alluding to the metaphysical foundation of all being, an answer to a whole host of philosophical conundrums: BOTH. *Relativity* is the answer. For the duality is simply the *relative* separation of The One, God, the all-pervading Source Energy, the *nothing* in the axiom: "Nothing can be created or destroyed, only forever rearranged." As cliché as it may sound, *Everything is Energy*. This is the same as saying that all things are God.

Exploding into spacetime, accumulating as matter, made into life through the Holy Mother, all forms are *relative* expressions of their formless Source. And the ego is simply the accumulated, biologically-enlivened matter mistaking itself as being only and absolutely itself. Egoism is the false perception that the duality is absolute, belying the non-dual Base of Being through which duality is given form. So it is that the answer to these interrelated questions is the same as the answer to most questions: *everything*. It's not one truth or another, it's their conflation into The Truth. This, of course, alludes to what's called *enlightenment*: the relatively distinct awakening to its root indistinction: God.

We can't change The Truth, only our relationship to It, and *with* It. The awakening changes the awareness of one's essential, un-dissolvable nature, that which all relativity dissolves *into*. In doing so one's mind fully awakens to the truths spoken through their hearts. This doesn't change their nature, or remove the relativity of distinction innate to their duality, it simply permits them, the embodied distinction, the pervasive peace, comfort, unity and sense of ultimate indistinction that's the same inheritance and everlasting Self bequeathed to every form of Self at birth. It gives them the peace of knowing, in one example of the truths endlessly cascading from this Truth, that we don't go anywhere when we die *because we're already there*.

Only when we're aware that we move through God *as* Its forms do we fully become the living truth, our heads matched to our hearts. It is at this point of supreme, revelatory joy that the instinctive awareness of The One no longer claws at the chrysalis set between heart and mind, between sensing and knowing, but merges fully one into the other, having broken through the perceived divisions that it now knows *aren't* absolute, the dual self now free to fly through the Self that it most truly is. In this way have the awakened 'come home' to the eternal truth whilst still living the duality, like visiting home while still in the world, as though sitting on the front porch, as it were, peacefully set beside the great hearth, the final threshold only crossed upon their bodily death, when the dividing curtain falls and the duality is completely removed. This is what

Trevor Hall alludes to in one of the best lines ever sung into song: *You're not running out, you're really running in.*

Amongst the resultant effects grown from this metaphysical ground of all truth are the aforementioned laws, *nothing is created or destroyed, only endlessly remade, and every action has an equal and opposite reaction.* This latter law goes by many names, extending into every discipline. The Law of Attraction, The Law of Manifestation, The Law of Correspondance, The Law of Inseparability, The Law of One. Whatever you call it, and however you come by it, it's fundamental to metaphysical existence, and it essentially says that *everything is reciprocal.* Everything grows and degrades relative to both how it acts and how, in a reaction that's equal in force and nature but opposite in its directionality, it's reacted *to.* That which we 'put out' into the world we take in from the world. Everything we do *to* another is done to ourselves, through the One Source of which everything is, reflecting the fact that *there is no 'other.'* Just as everything we do *for* another is done *for* ourselves. All bridges go both ways.

Whether we're passing along good energy, the height of which is unconditional love, or bad energy, all the hate and anger that typically comes from the interaction of the beleaguered psyche, the insecure ego and the pressures placed upon the body and brain, it's *immediately reciprocated.* This, then, is the heart of morality, and all moral social systems: *Do unto others as you'd have them do unto you, because what you do to them you do to One.*

The Master Therapist is *Psilocybe cubensis*. Why? Because its effect upon the individual consciousness transceiving the Universal Consciousness is to increase the frequency of transmission between the self and the Self to such a degree where anything once seemingly fixed and finite in the consciousness becomes unfixed and can't cling to it, because it's vibrating at the higher frequency nearing the unfixed and infinite. By doing so, it inoculates the local, singular self with a greater sense of the divine state of the non-localized Universal Self that's like the mycelium underlying and interconnecting all of Life; the entirely inseparable interbeing that's the metaphysical foundation of physical and mental being. And by thereby peeling the small self, the individualistic ego identity, from the Big Self, the universal spiritual identity, one gains an invaluable perspective upon themselves and their existence and the totality of universal interbeing. This experience thereby grants them an invaluable reprieve from every form of suffering, every form of which is bound to the self-conceptions of their

individualization. And through this experience they're gifted the more direct awareness of their egos as being that which is experienced BY the One Self, better sensing the Observer, or Self, versus the self it observes *through*.

The One Truth

Peel the Labels From Your Lamp

Self-awareness, or 'sentience,' is a double-edged sword, and the evolution of the human race is based upon our ability to wield it. While we think of ourselves as the most advanced form of life on the planet, and in the ways of one edge of the sword we *are*, the other edge is equally sharp, and divisively cuts us, the planet and life into painfully-perceived slices. These bloody divisions not only prevent our evolution and impede upon our best abilities to use the other edge of the sword, but undermine the ability of Mother Earth to support us in the first place, imperiling humanity, life and the planet in ways that no other organism can. At the same time it's only through evil that goodness is fully known, and only through the ego that egolessness may be glimpsed. And so cutting oneself with one side of the sword is how we learn to wield the sword.

So it is that humanity is now set upon an imperiling precipice in its evolution, possessing both the means to construct a great, glorious future for ourselves and the planet whilst possessing unparalleled capacities to destroy ourselves and all of that which life depends upon. And that destructiveness is based upon an inflated awareness of the illusorily-independent individual, or 'self,' that's actually only *relatively* separated, being an *individualization* of

Source. Only when the perceived self makes the mistake of believing that it's separable from its Source, that anything can be perfectly divided from any other thing, and only when society fails to teach us the truth of our complete inseparability with the Source Self and every one of its infinite evolving manifestations, does sentience sicken.

Sentience arose from a more advanced mind than anything this planet, and maybe the whole of the universe, has ever seen; a mind that's capable of doing things that no other organism can. That's obvious. But no less obvious is the fact that what becomes self-aware is thereafter afflicted with the need to know and define and make that perceived 'self' better, especially in relationship to everyone and everything else. This is all the more true when that perceived self exists in an environment such as modern America wherein the ego is glorified, where 'self-worth' is a synonym for 'class' and 'financial worth,' and where even what's confused for spirituality is idolatrous, the personality of Christ glorified at the expense and concealment of the fact that 'Christ' means *anyone fully awakened to the fact that they exist within God, the Truth*. Only by pretending like Christ is a *person*, rather than a state of being, could religion be used to mentally enslave. For only by pretending to control the way to everlasting truth can any emperor and his empire control the people.

Yet, the truth is everlastingly, ubiquitously extant. Never does it belong to anyone or anything less than everyone and everything, awaiting its rediscovery in the innermost

cloisters of the heart's interchange with the mind. And, in this quest to see what's commonly called 'enlightenment,' the separable self is the force of blindness. The ego, or self-conception, is hatched by sentience, or self-awareness, and, as it grows in this unsettled, ignorantly-susceptible sense of absolute separation exacerbated by a modern environment whereby every pervasive belief system tells it that it has its own identity entirely separate from the whole, hatched by accident, independent or absent of God (the lies of materialism, science, atheism AND religion), and where society rewards the self relative to its sense of largesse and superiority over all the 'otherness' that doesn't actually exist, it's perpetually afflicted with false needs related to its absolute, deceived separability of self.

When there's a 'self' that perceives itself as standalone, as separate from everyone and everything else, it's necessarily the case that this isolation of perceived being creates a vulnerability that then must be fortified and defended, in order to prevent its own demise. One may see this as a type of egoistic survivalism, and, after physical survival, there's no more dominant contemporary drive than this egoist fortification: the growth and sustenance of the 'self.' This is the basis of all human evil and conflict, including greed and every form of nationalism, tribalism, religiosity and every other of the near innumerable labels and categorizations that we apply and enforce upon the world, life and one another, all of which act to artificially-broaden the gap between ourselves and any of those 'others' on the other side of those endless illusory lines,

every such line being like a bloody slice from the divisive side of the sword of sentience. For each of these illusory definitions belie the spiritual, non-dualist foundation of life and all existence, the one core truth demonstrating that everything is a form of the One Thing, the One Source of all there is, a multiplicity of the same pure presence of conscious energy, God, the undefinable, irreducible, universal Base of Being. So it is that every egoist definition enforces a division that need not exist, and which thereafter necessarily promotes every possible conflict with anyone and anything that isn't on the included side of that confining, excluding, deluded line. For this is what it is to truly near 'enlightenment:' *to exist in the truth that everyone is a finite, mortal form of the everlasting God.*

This One Truth is concealed with every self-definition we conceive of and apply. Every label we adhere to ourselves that never perfectly sticks, every box that we force ourselves into which we never perfectly fit, every boundary that we build between ourselves and everything and everyone else that we deceive ourselves into believing is absolute, and made of towering steel, all of which can only ever be relative and minor compared to the underlying inseparability, all such obstacles actually made of mud that The One Truth washes away as though they were never there... *because they were only imagined.* All of these egoistic exercises are inherently self-deceiving, blinding and divisive, and all of them create a type of toxic territoriality that's at the crux of not only all human conflict, and which motivate all greed and evil action of

'mine versus yours,' but which act to conceal The One Truth forever held in heart from reaching the mind and leading our thoughts and actions. When so divinely led, we are *of* The Tao, *on* The Way. Instead, living every form of the egoist lie projects a falsely defined, limited and labeled 'reality' onto an existence that's lived entirely within The One, as forms of the formless One Source of it all. It's as though we're bequeathed a lamp holding the eternal flame projecting the glorious white light of living truth upon all that we perceive, but it becomes so occluded with the sticky identifiers with which we, in our ignorance and by the encouragement of a society built by possessiveness, greed and identity, stick to ourselves, the labels of our self-investment, that we only see a diminished light projecting *those* stickers, like the walls of Plato's Cave, mistaking that occluded sight of projected false self for the Truth of Self. Everything reflected back to us reflects *this* projection, everyone and everything mirroring our self-deception.

The supreme, eternal, divine reality, on the other hand, recognizes no such definitions, labels or forms of 'realism' which deny that all things are One Thing. But I foresee that when everyone comes to know what they truly, essentially are, that is, a thing of the One Thing, a unique mortal manifestation of the immortal One, evolved through Mother Nature and Her holy incarnations of the One, then the crux of all conflict and spiritual blindness shall dissolve, and the third eyesight, spiritual sight, will open wide, and our pure perception shall usher us into the next stage in our evolution. *We must remove the artificial stickers of*

self-labeling from the lamp. This is the driving force of our progression as the sentient stewards of the Holy Mother: to possess the mental capacity that makes it possible to do all the amazing things that we do while having the strength *of* the knowledge of how not to cut ourselves, knowing and practicing the truest faith of innate spiritual oneness and the denial of the conflicting ego that's at the heart of all self-centered evil and its various occluding, sticking, deceiving ideologies threatening to destroy Mother, for egoism is inherent to the possessiveness imperiling Her.

The irony of a society obsessed with self-improvement or 'self-realization,' whether it be contained in the concept of 'enlightenment' or in reaching some egoistic class status, is that *true* self-realization and enlightenment aren't a matter of adding something and becoming better than we are, but of *removing* everything that blinds us to the truest sight of what we most truly, essentially are; what we are when no self-conception, no invention, no defense of self exists. Enlightenment is *subtraction*, not addition. Becoming oneself is *tearing down the walls*, not building them up; is digging into the dirt, into the Base of Being, sinking into the irreducible center of all Self, not building some hugely compensating, towering edifice of ego that only better conceals the truth the more it towers over and atop it. That is, enlightenment exists *beneath* the mind and everything it tells itself and is told and believes that in any way denies the One Truth. Every thought of self conceals the Self. Only by sinking *beneath* the mind may anyone arrive where everyone most essentially is, un-invented,

having jettisoned all belief, all thought, dwelling in the permanence which gives birth to every impermanent form.

The best spiritual writing and practice is about *reduction*, not amassment. It's about simplifying, not complicating. It's about pointing your mind into what you've known all along, but have built up too many self-conceptions to see. It's about the foundation upon which every mental structure is built, not the structures themselves. In fact, I find that most 'spiritual disciplines' essentially act to muddy the water with imagined specifications, structures, rituals, hierarchies, philosophies and the personalities of prophets. It's as though the seeker seeks to peer into the bottom of the pool in which everyone and everything always bathes, but can't quite see it, and so he thrashes around and waves his arms and stomps from place to place, agitating the ground with every invented movement and confused sight reflected off of the disturbed surface of the water, confusing those images with truth, when the truth can only be seen when the surface is calm, the water translucent, the act of submitting and sinking being the only way to drop down into the grounding truth of Being.

So it is that enlightenment exists relative to *non-movement*; to being where and what you cannot invent, the subject having reduced their self-conception to the point where they live by and perpetually practice the sacred art of oneness at the Base of Being: We're all unique, relatively distinct forms of the perfectly pervasive, indistinct One. It's to *this* eternal metaphysical foundation

that everything and everyone returns, and is forever remade, the holy union of Father Energy and Mother Matter, the phallus and the womb, the meeting of the two triangles forming the Star of David. We're untouchable and entirely invulnerable there, in the everlasting Heaven sung of by every heart. This is the answer to all conflict and all egoistic delusion and its concealment of The One Truth.

Only by the holy revelations of this non-dual basis of reality, and especially by this practiced spiritual awareness and denying of all divisive ego identity, can love overgrow every division of evil built between us. Be who and what you most naturally are, free from any need to define and defend and accrue and build yourself up into what the ego dictates. And this is not a communist ideal. Don't let the conservatives fool you. In fact, this metaphysical construct was chosen by God because it permits a limitless variety of and perspective upon the One Being. So it is that we must celebrate what the duality of One into Infinite of One means: an endlessness of perfectly unique experience for the One Being, God, experienced as infinite forms of Itself. We are the duality living within the non-duality, the point where the eye looking up and looking down become one.

The Way of the Water-Bearer

Be the Cause, And the Effect Will Follow

The extrinsic is always an emanation of the intrinsic. This is true of Spirit, the One, for whom all are impermanent, unique emanations, and for those emanations themselves. Everything unfolds from the Source, just as all plants sprout from their seeds, and are made into their most complete forms by being planted in the most nutrient-rich, well-watered soils; soils that only *became* rich because of the cumulative death of the preceding, sprouted seeds. The extrinsic is the environment by which the intrinsic unfolds itself, the best environments producing the best fruit, even as every environment is nothing more or less than the accumulation of the intrinsic *becoming* extrinsic. Alas, only the intrinsic may we control. The seed becomes the plant that produces the fruit, the past never dead, not even the past, the past the presently-producing future. Thus, we mustn't focus on the effects, but upon the cause. We must be the horse, and try not to put the cart before it. We must become the water-bearer before we can bear the healing, nourishing waters for both ourselves and all of life.

All that we pour into the sustenance and fertilization of the whole is as the water from our own vessels. Thus is all fruition relative to the vessels that contain that which, when naturally poured, nourish it into being. The water

that we pour *is* the fruit that we fertilize. There is no separation between anything, including between the input and the output. Relative to any individualization of God, this 'reaping what's sown' is based upon its own inputs.

All that we take into ourselves becomes all that we pour out of ourselves in the influence of others. This is true even as most people focus most of their energy on the *effects*, on what they *can't* control, on what they want for themselves external to themselves, so fixated with altering their environments that they forget to focus on the one thing that can and will *do* the altering. So it is that we must not concern ourselves with forcing the fruit, with the ideal output and attempting to produce some controlled state of fruiting, but with cleansing our waters and fortifying our vessel such that our purest, best-cleansing, most nourishing waters naturally flow out from us. You can't slake the thirst of others pouring from an empty or cracked vessel, you can't improve the lives of others pouring out fouling fluids, and you can't do anything external but *from* the internal. Focus on the water within, on the cleansing and strengthening of the vessel, and the rest will follow.

This is why the beginning of any improvement we make for life is the flushing, filling and fortifying of our own vessels, the steadfast focus on all that we take in and make into ourselves, and why everything starts with the nutrition of our bodies and the cleansing of our minds. We must wipe away all that dirties and denatures that comes into us, body and mind. For the body becomes the mind, the mind

is the maker of thoughts, and all inner thought leads to outward action. Thus must we attend to our own vessel, and the water which it carries, and thereby attend to all, for all that we are within naturally comes to be poured and ripple on forever without, soaked up by the Everything. We must focus on health, the state of the vessel, and upon the purging of every invented truth about ourself that conceals the un-invented, Universal Self, before we can best become a true servant of the Infinite of the One without. Only with purified waters of being held by a clean, unbroken vessel may we be a water-bearer for everyone.

Focus on what's within, and the without shall be reflected back in kind. All rivers return to the sea, just as all that we pour out flows back to us, for this is the reciprocal force of Spirit; The Way of the One. "We must be the change we wish to see in the world," Ghandi said. But in order to become that change, we must first change ourselves, and, by changing what we are, we become what the world needs of us. And in the process we remember the holiness of interbeing, the totality of interdependency, and find that there's no difference between becoming ourselves and the whole of the world reflecting it back. This is the philosophical, spiritual and scientific law of inseparability; of the equal and opposite reaction; of the Law of Attraction; of nothing that is escaping the reciprocating accord of its becoming, the eternally-rippling interchange of everything within being cast out, becoming the waves that always come crashing back onto the sending shore.

The End of Evil

Living by the Spiritual Rule

The root of all evil is identity, excepting the enlightenment that lays the One Universal Identity bare within the heart-mind, and, thus, brings it to bear upon the thoughts and endeavors of the previously illusorily 'separated individual.' Without separable identity, that which is formed by the ego and grows from a materialist misconception of sentience, or self-awareness, evil is impossible. Yes, even without identity we may, like all non-sentient agents of Nature, still harm one another, but only as an extension of the natural drive of self-preservation and balancing order endemic to the membership of Nature, in Her innate initiative to sustain Herself, as when a predator predated in balancing the lifeforms and forces of the sustainable order.

Such forms of harm are only harm of the part of the whole for the sake of the whole, whereas evil is a form of harm which oppressively feeds off of weakness for the sake of one or more persons or groups gaining advantage over one or more 'other' persons or groups, in disregard of the whole. Alas, even evil shall eventually be seen to serve the good, for we only learn of the good of serving the whole through the lessons of evil parasitically feeding off of the whole. Thus, only through the Devil may we understand God, the whole, and Its embodiments through Mother

Nature. Through the Holy Mother the seed of formless, all-inclusive Spirit gives endless, infinitely-varied, forever-evolving form to Itself. Yet, even as we're actually selves of the One Self, modern man is denied spiritually-sound non-dualist instruction and instead taught to see itself as separable individuals, a mistruth continually affirmed and reinforced by the materialism and egotism ruling mankind.

The separable 'self' is the core illusion hatched by the egotistic delusion, for our limited powers of perception (evolved to *be* limited so that the One, *as* we, may exist as physical beings) paired with misconstrued sentience and the aforementioned prevailing modern paradigms, dictate a distinction that, like every truth except the one truth, is always *relative*, never absolute. All 'individuals,' either misleadingly conceived of as being without a soul (atheistic materialism) or as having a 'separate soul' (for the religious control of falsely-separated beings punishable through a mythical 'afterlife,' or via karma and 'being caught in the cycle of birth and death,' discarding the gift of the present), tend to believe in 'individualism' as an extension of the power-and-ego-propelled development of humanity. Both science and religion portray existence as separable. This, of course, didn't come about by accident, but as an extension of the corruptibility of the deluded, relatively separable self, or ego, being compelled to dominate all other such relatively separable selves, the course of which is the same as the history of humanity and its institutions.

The one dominant drive of human history is, of course, power, i.e. control, i.e. the ability of the falsely-conceived 'individual self' and his or her tribe to possess as much and have as much power over the 'other' as possible, including the drive to possess and profitably exploit our fellow man, lifeforms, the planet, and the universe in its totality. Everything entering the minds of modern men originated in this ego identification exercise, being born of the same misunderstood, misled sentience, and being borne *along* by the intertwined history of empire, religion, science, materialism, conservatism and social development that all piggyback upon the egoistic delusions. This is why these disciplines, developments and ideologies are all 'fruit from the poisoned tree,' because they're all based upon the lie that anything can ever be *only* itself. This pestilence, branching from ego and science into separable identities, inevitably ushers in every form of conflict creating every pressure and all motivations catalyzing every cause of evil.

True spiritual revelation, on the other hand, typically falling under the overlapping headings of 'spiritual but not religious (SBNR),' 'non-dualism,' 'monism' and 'pantheism,' and something which I myself termed 'monoexistentialism' in my twenties before I'd even heard the aforementioned terms, and arrived at through various methods of contemplation, observation and intuition and their philosophical synthesis, reveals that everything is an inconceivably complex unfolding of the Original Cause, God, or Spirit, or the endless other names applied to the Nameless One, into infinite forms of Itself formed and

forever evolving for the sake of endlessly varied, perfectly unique experience of the One Existence. *We're the effects of the core cause of the One becoming the Infinite.* To paraphrase Huxley: All science is a reduction of multiplicity into classification and identity. Science will eventually affirm what non-dualist spiritual theologians and practicing mystics like myself have known for millennia: there's one perfect, pure source of energetic consciousness ever expanding to fit Its environment via *relative* differentiation.

Both science and religion, and, of course, most modern political and economic ideologies, make the same mistake of denying this metaphysical foundation of all truth, with endless evil effect: they draw lines and enforce the resultant divisions as though those narrowly-defined lines are absolute, when those lines are largely mismeasures formed for prejudicial purposes and belie the underlying unity and one true universal identity. Every conceived 'individual identity' can only ever be a relative distinction of the ultimately indistinct, and is always erroneous and misleading relative to the extent that it's thought to be absolute. So it is that I assert: ALL IDENTITY WHICH DENIES THAT ALL THINGS ARE FORMS OF ONE THING IS THE OFFSPRING OF EGOISTICALLY, FALSELY-INTERPRETED SENTIENCE AND THE SOURCE OF ALL SUBSEQUENT EVIL.

One can only commit an evil against another (look at that word: another) because they perceive them to be *an other*. At this point, whilst this knowledge is spreading and being practiced and is gradually seeded throughout our

social systems, there are two answers to this root of all evil, separable identity, both of which are passable to and possessable by not every 'individual' with a 'separate soul,' but to/by every individualization of the One Soul, Spirit:

(1) Follow the path of the sages towards non-self. That is, take up no identity whatsoever, for any identity you take up can only reflect a relative truth that will mislead and constrain you, causing you to constrict and move away from your limitless divine nature, while also limiting your capacity to purely perceive the world around you based upon the projections of this narrowing ego identity that most never even know that they're projecting, and/or

(2) If you *must* have an identity, or if, like me, you come to see non-identity as essentially indistinct from total identity, let that identity be A ONE OF THE ONE. Either way, once this Seed of Spirit fully sprouts in the heart and grows into the mind to fruit, evil becomes impossible, for there's no longer any 'others,' only forms of the formless One, selves of the Self, and, therefore, to wrong one is to wrong One is to wrong Oneself, at the root of oneself. This is the heart of both true, non-dual spirituality and its natural extension into morality and all human social systems and endeavors: THERE IS NO 'OTHER.' Thus the **Spiritual Rule**, the advanced form of the Golden Rule: **Treat others as you'd have yourself treated, because they're forms of your Self.**

Third Eye Blindfolded

Universal Law #1: Separation is an Illusion

At this point in my journey into my Self, into the Self, having had countless epiphanies as to the non-dualist nature of spiritual revelation, the fact that all are embodiments of and maintain constant communion and communication with the One Universal Being, God, as I do daily (even as most are unaware of this holy communion and do the divine dance only unconsciously), I find the concept of the individual soul and accompanying concepts like reincarnation and 'descending or ascending' into an 'afterlife' to be akin to a type of spiritual egotism.

The separable soul and the 'life after life' idea that this divine life, this gift of God to Its unique embodiments, is but a warm up for the realer 'afterlife,' are manmade artifices inseparable from the divide and conquer strategy sewn into the invisible blindfold placed over the head of humanity to conceal the empowering, freeing truth. As Yoda dictates, in a line borrowed from all sages: "You must unlearn what you've learned." These ideas falsely assert a divided base of being, claiming every individualization of the One to be a separate individual that's always been distinct from everything and everyone else, that you have a 'soul' that belongs exclusively to you, and that it's in a constant state of trying to surpass other souls and

graduate and avoid being reincarnated, or, worse, that it's destined for an eternity in pure anguish or perfect bliss based upon passing some cosmic test. Learn the first law of the universe: *You're not separate, but a one of The One.*

There is nowhere to 'go' when you die, because you're already there, within God, one of the Infinite of One. Believing anything that tells you otherwise can only gradually make you okay with committing the constant evils against our fellow ones of the One that we're taught through all false teachings to turn a blinded third eye towards. A separate soul and reincarnation and the afterlife... these ideas are taught to us in order to reduce, divide, control and conquer us, being like classism, egotism and tribalism applied to something to which such false divides can NEVER adhere: Spirit; God; the Nameless One.

Do you not see that Spirit, God, the nameless One, is essential unity, and recognizes no such forms of division? Such premises are either entirely ignorant of, else mistakenly dismissive of, the foundational philosophical and theosophical revelations of non-separation and spiritual indistinction that silently govern the world, the truth which humanity must *remember*, and reawaken to. All contradicting, inherently divisive ideologies completely misunderstand the metaphysical construct and its gifts and purposes (described in detail throughout my writings), and are closer to the mind-controlling, narrowing lies innate to most religion, and to the falsely absolute classifications of science and the misleading, socially-dominating modern

philosophies and ideologies of capitalism, materialism, realism and conservatism, all of which represent the evils of divide and conquer. These belief systems occlude the third eye *by design* so that we can't see our essential indistinction with everyone else, blinding the believer of such falsities to the essential unitive truth. Why? Because spiritual truth is the most freeing form of revelation in existence, and unbinds you from the invisible chains bound around humanity to control and feed off of us! Believing these lies means being blinded to your unity with the Everything, the wool having been pulled over your third eye. Removing the blindfold is the first step in seeing Truth.

Modern Society is a Sickness

The Five-Headed Horseman of the Apocalypse

Human community is natural and healthy. Community is, in fact, at the root of the natural human condition. Nothing heals, protects and reveals the illuminating light of the shared spiritual source Self like the connection (love) of community. Modern human society, on the other hand, is unnatural, and sickens. A great multitude have commented upon and analyzed why this is so, including myself in my own literary multitude, and everyone feels it to varying degrees, with most simply suppressing the sense with 'realist' thoughts like 'that's simply the reality of things, so why invest time and energy into the naïve fight against reality?' Yet, not only is modern human society not the only reality, it's not even the natural reality; far from it, in fact. I recently spent a month in the redwoods in a natural condition, and returning to society and being assaulted by its assorted unnaturalities, injustices and pressures, my certainty of the plague of modern society is more concrete than ever. I say that I go into nature to heal from the plague, return to society to sicken, and when I can't take the sickness anymore, I flee into the freeing, healing forest once more, until such time when I'm compelled to return.

So, what is it about modern human society that sickens? Why are more and more of us becoming attuned to this fact, and seeking salvation? Why are some of the most

popular films and books based upon the few that not only sensed the societal sickness, but who had the courage to flee from it, and dared to live a life in denial of all the mental, economic and political intrusions upon natural, healthy human life (*Into the Wild* and *Captain Fantastic* are two of my favorite films, and *Walden* is even more powerfully applicable to modern society than it was to Thoreau's society – my first book, *Infinite of One*, largely overlaps with *Walden*, even as I'd yet to read it by then)?

My answer is that modern humanity is ruled by five overlapping paradigms handed-down over the generations from one conquering army and its inheriting aristocracy to the next, all based upon 'divide and conquer:' a population divided in its identities, in its various individualisms and political, genealogical, ideological and religious tribes, governed by the lie of absolute separation, is easy to control and exploit, because it's already engaged in intertribal warfare and hasn't the awareness or the strength to see or break its chains, whereas a united humanity, such as a humanity that knows (as I do) that it's an evolving embodiment of Spirit, is impossible to oppress.

Alas, we're more divided than ever, and that's purposefully conditioned. For it's through divide and conquer systems and their constant indoctrination of the population that most human thought, belief and activity is ruled. And it's by having a mind in chains that we're secretly enslaved, with the *least* aware calling it 'freedom.' These five ways of understanding reality and our place in it are against the

natural human condition, and unnatural cause always breeds unnatural effect. Thus the societal sickness.

The first source of sickness is **Christianity**, at least in its current form. Religiosity in general is problematic, as they all teach narrowing mistruths and false divides that don't exist, and most have, like Christianity, had the messages of the rebel, freeing prophets absorbed and corrupted by the empires which, in most historical cases, the prophets actually rebelled *against*. The pure Christianity, the words and teachings of the spiritual philosopher known as 'Christ,' has been concealed behind the façade of the modern Church. So it is that, more than any other religion, it's Christianity that pulls the wool over the third eye in 'the land of freedom.' Americans are, in my estimation and from my perspective, the most spiritually unintelligent, misinformed people on the planet. Why this is so is too extensive of a subject for this commentary, but if you read my other work you'll come to understand why. Generally, the first unnatural division adulterating and sickening the human condition is the idea that we're divided from God and Nature, which Christianity preaches. Nature is sin. This is actually antithetical to the natural human condition and our true nature: we're all manifestations of God. We're not only inseparable from God, but indistinct. We're forms of the One. And we're inseparable from everyone and everything else as a consequence, including the rest of life. Nature is innately divine, *including* the whole of humanity.

Christ knew this, and the 'pagans' that preceded him knew it as well, but after his death his lessons were captured by the Eastern Roman Empire and turned into modern Christianity at the Council of Nicaea, where any part of his teaching that impeded upon the power of Empire to control and exploit the weakness of the people was edited out of the official text, i.e. *the Bible*. Christianity teaches the worst form of egotism (the opposite of spiritual truth), *idolatry*, which asserts that only one person was ever of God and could divine God's will. What greater evil than to deceive the people as to their divine nature, to rip them apart from one another in mind, and to enforce the utter falsity that only one person was ever born of God and had 'his' authority to speak the truth? This is the height of egotism, the belief in the separate self and its supremacy over other forms of the Self, which, again, is actually the *opposite* of spirituality. In truth God speaks to everyone through their hearts, where their own prophet resides; it's all a matter of the mind's ability to decipher the heart.

Alas, there's no way that divide and conquer imperialism could allow this truth to be widely disseminated and known, because it's inherently empowering and freeing, hence the divisions clearly drawn in the Bible between God and man and between man and Nature and between man and himself, through a fickle, wrathful 'God' that thinks tribally, absurdly asserting that only some are 'the chosen people,' which, again, is antithetical to the spiritual truth that *all are divine*. What's more divisive than everyone warring over the right to call themselves 'the chosen

people?,' and what's more opposed to and dishonoring of true spiritual revelation than claiming that any tribe is more of the One in the infinite than any other? America inherited this sword of imperialism, and our blinded, divided people, taught that they were born into sin and must be saved, sold an evil as though that evil is innate, have been obstructed from finding spiritual truth ever since. So long as Christianity stands for spirituality in America, it'll continue to be at the root of societal sickness.

The second source of sickness is **Realism**. Many trace the root of realism to Thucydides' *The History of the Peloponnesian War*, when the conquering Athenians said to the conquered: "Right, as the world goes, is only in question between equals in power, while the strong do what they can and the weak suffer what they must." The idea is generally that humans are inherently evil (confirmed by the Bible), and that all human action is an extension of this evil, sinful nature, and that to act or believe otherwise is simply to be naively 'unrealistic.'

So realism has become the catch-all excuse, backed by false divine authority per Christianity, that we do evil to one another by our natures, and that's simply the nature and reality of things. *This is a lie*. It's no more than a justification used by evil-doers to tell themselves they're 'just being realistic' when they commit evil deeds; mostly the types of evils that we've all learned, through our social conditioning, to ignore, because, you know, 'that's just the nature and reality of things.' In fact, it's reasonable to

assert that all modern business is based upon this 'realist' justification, as when an employee is paid only what will compel him or her to work, entirely without ownership in his or her work, and regardless of his or her needs or the resultant quality of life impact. Or a lease that also denies ownership (equity) to all of its residents because they can't afford a mortgage, and exploits this fact by forcing them to flush most of their aforementioned minimized wages down the drain just to have the right to have somewhere to live.

It's inevitable that such accepted injustices cause evil in countless ways through the oppressed being forced to make the rich richer just to survive. Worse, we're taught to lionize the greatest such evil-doers as 'successful businessmen.' And everyone thereby adversely affected *feels* this evil, even as the ability to understand and the courage to justly respond varies dramatically, with the few progressives denounced as 'unrealistic.' So we can see how the groundwork for the sickness is being laid. The truth is that we're not inherently evil but inherently *corruptible* through the vulnerabilities of the human body and mind.

The Spirit, or Self, or God, speaking through the heart, the gateway of energy into human biological matter, is *incorruptible*, and, thus, incapable of impelling evil action. The goal of any truly moral, spiritual being is to understand and fortify their weak points (this, in turn, is an extensive discussion of human ego, psyche and physiological habits and weakening dependencies) so as not to allow corruptibility to *become* evil, whilst simultaneously

pursuing those spiritual rewards which increase by the *giving*, rather than encouraging and exploiting the weaknesses that perpetuate evil in our thought and action.

The third source of sickness is **Materialism**; that is, materialism as a *philosophical* concept, not as an extension of capitalistic covetousness, even though they're linked. Essentially, materialism stands in contrast with idealism by asserting that everything is random and accidental in derivation, and devoid of meaning; that the world is entirely mechanistic, and that the forces and phenomena that govern not just the natural realm but the human mind itself, consciousness, have no source and no meaning other than what we imagine them to. Belief in materialism is, thus, the third division; the third cut in the natural human condition and spiritual identity that is, in the metaphysical Base of Being buried beneath the scientific measurements that reinforce materialism and realism, actually entirely inseparable. When you take this prevailing modern stance, you're investing in evil, because no one is connected to anyone else, there is no God, no meaning, only accidents evolving through a cold, careless universe.

This is utter nonsense. Our ancestors and the pagans and countless philosophers and mystics like myself knew/know it's nonsense, just like everyone knows in their hearts, the mind playing the interpreter of truths that come into the heart, the source of truth. And that truth includes the fact that 'idealism,' which we're conditioned to dismiss as 'unrealistic,' actually has it right: Consciousness is the

source of reality. It *is* God. It's the pure, irreducible conscious energy at the very heart of existence around which all being is compelled, or *impelled*, to exist and evolve to fit its natural environment, mutualistically assisting the continuity of all of its manifested lifeforms. Science is learning this, too, and it's inevitable, from my perspective, that one of the greatest ironies of the modern human belief system is that what most scientists believe that they're disproving, the existence of the unitive, non-dual Source, or God, is what they're ever closer to actually proving, even as they'll continue to struggle with what to call this, doing anything possible to avoid the word 'God.'

The fourth source of sickness is **Capitalism**. I'm not entirely against capitalism, for I believe that people have the right to use their own space and be self-motivated in endeavor, rather than any type of 'command economy' forcing people to do otherwise, or forcing an equality of ownership and compensation regardless of merit. However, the use of a thing, such as land, is not true ownership. Legally we *call* it ownership, but in truth you can't 'own' what you belong to, and what you can only ever rightfully *use*. Per *Fight Club*, by believing we own things we become owned by them, and are indoctrinated in the greed and classism of envisioning our 'worth' through the occluded lens of possession and illusive ownership, which, in turn, is exceedingly corruptive of the human mind and inflating of the misleading, insecure, forever self-defensive ego that leads us *away* from spiritual truth, all of which ripples out into an endless causality of

evil effect making capitalist society one big pestilential swamp. But when you've been mired in that swamp your entire life you tend not to see it, and adapt to it as 'reality.'

Alas, a critique of capitalism is too extensive of an undertaking for this space, but, again, see the work of myself and countless others, and consider the general critique that one of the greatest resultant evils of being ruled by capitalism is that, when you simply understand its causal arc and inevitabilities, it consolidates everything of value in the hands of ever fewer by rewarding the parasitic exploitation of every form of human weakness and every lack of consideration for and protection of the planet, all of which are backed by Christianity, realism and materialism, the synergistic sickness of the modern pooling pestilence.

For me, the evils of capitalism come down to *equity exclusion*. My personal motto is 'equity or exploitation.' If a person lives in a dwelling, or works for a business, or otherwise lives or does absolutely anything without having an ownership stake in that life and those endeavors, without a share of ownership commensurate with meritocracy (i.e. not automatically and unjustly equal, but based upon contributed value), then evil is being committed. The unjustly unprotected people and places of the planet are thus leached off of, with the inevitable result being that those that invest in this economic 'reality' are ever more corrupted and pulled towards their egos and away from all spiritual truth and justice, whilst those people and places on the wrong side of the entirely

unsustainable equation can only remain weak and divided from other competing workers and dwellers, all living stressed-out, unnatural lives in cutthroat competition with everyone else that they wrongly believe that they're absolutely separated from; with their holy brothers and sisters with whom, beneath the surface, they actually share the same spiritual identity, and with whom it's actually *far* more natural, and loving, revealing and healing, to form fully mutualistic relationships with.

I'm reminded of my time at *UCSB* studying 'business economics,' and taking accounting courses. For one need look no further than the balance sheet of any business to see that the extraction of everything in the assets column and the oppression of everyone and everything in the liabilities column is innate to growing the equity column, and so long as you're excluded from the equity column you're on the wrong side of the balance sheet, and are being parasitically fed off of. And *consumerism*, which is really an extension of capitalism more than a separate force, is the encouraged idea that you're never complete until you purchase and possess a completion that, in reality, can never be had this way, because you were *born* complete, and that can't be taken away from you. For all of these reasons and countless more, capitalism is as unsustainable to human life as it is to life's hosting planet.

The fifth and final source of sickness is **Conservatism**. What 'conservatism' really means is 'conserving everything that allows the wealthy and powerful to continue

exploiting the poor and powerless.’ It’s simply greed, the *conservation* of the traditions of the ruling class inherited from overseas empires, and it’s rooted in the previous four sources of sickness, all rolled into one nasty poisonous ball sitting in the belly of humanity, the planet and life as a whole, metastasizing and slowly suffocating us. Yes, all sorts of parades and spectacles and propaganda are constantly elicited to trick the uncritical mind into believing conservatism has something to do with all of these glorious, honorable things, like a democracy that doesn’t actually exist (we’re a plutocratic republic headed towards oligarchy) and forms of patriotism and freedom that are really about nationalistic supremacy and fascism and the illusion of a one-way form of freedom (Americans are largely clueless about their own supposedly guiding principles, including the fact that *freedom* is a two way street). So conservatism wraps all the sickness up in a big shiny bow, hypnotizes you with parades and waving flags manipulating your sense of ethos and honor (honor is actually what’s being *killed* by conservatism), then sells it to you so you can buy your own sickening enslavement.

Ready for the inconvenient truth? Without interpreters like me, and without books like this, and without the ability to inspire people like you towards uncovering these truths in the convergence of your heart and mind, humanity shall inevitably continue to be divided and conquered, shall not truly know God, shall be denied its natural divinity and hidden interbeing, and shall slink towards oblivion upon an uprising planet. Ousting the Five-Headed Horseman is our

best defense against morality-murdering marauders;
against every tyrannical toddler trying to trump the Truth.

The Water-Bearer

Gathered in Secrecy, Poured in Silence

The nearest anyone comes to possessing anyone or anything is in the release of the need to claim possession. For possession is always inversely proportionate to the clutching grip, the greater the fear of not possessing something or someone always being equal to the enforcement of non-possession. For nothing that may be possessed is truly possessed by force of that which may possess it, but only by the reciprocally-binding force of that which or whom may be possessed equally possessing the possessor. The more that you force it, the more that you force the real thing away from you. Your pull is its push. The faster and more rapacious the predator, the faster and more elusive the prey; prey that falls into the lap of the predator only when that same predator stops predating, and let's go of the need to identify itself as the predator.

Might this be the true, paradoxical Secret? That the truth and wealth of oneself always comes unforced, by letting go, by not clutching, not defining, not needing to possess, hoard, claim and identify? That all things come as equal and opposite effects of their innately-reciprocating volition? That giving away is true wealth (accumulation of spiritual reward)? That one may only hold in hand what's held not by the tightening first, but what alights upon the

opening palm? That the only way for The Way, The Force, God, to grant control to Its manifestations is through the unclenching fist, the release of control, submitting to faith?

To appear to possess something through manipulation, exploitation, force or any other ego-led, misguided means is to possess only its illusion; only the outward appearance of what's believed to be possessed, and may only thus be possessed in such a way as to delude and weigh down the apparent possessor relative to the extent of their delusion. For all that's had in this way is simultaneously not actually possessed while also being taken from the rightful non-possessors, all those making no possessive claims, for they're impelled not by the gripping ego but by the innate, useful value of that which seeks realization *through* them.

Those whom, in accord with this natural law of reciprocity, The Way, shall, in releasing their need of what they want, allow the space for that want to become true, for its truth is relative to the realization of its value; its usefulness to life that may only be known when it's *not* being claimed and hoarded in the illusive, deluding, egotistic glory of its pretend ownership. Their release of possession shall enact their possession. Their relinquishing of power shall see them empowered in equal turn. Their poverty of matter and money shall manifest the wealth of energy and Spirit.

Those whom, in discord with this natural law of reciprocity, The Way, shall, in their inability to release their need of what they want, force its facsimile into the open space of true creation and possession, and rule by appearance and

deception, for their possession is untrue, their ownership an illusion that owns their illusory self in turn. Their power is forced and false, and shall turn upon them as soon as circumstance reveals the falsity of their claims and the insubstantiality of their shows, gradually manifesting their disempowerment. Their appearance of possession demonstrates their lack of possession. Their wealth of matter and money shall be their impoverishment of energy and Spirit, that which they displace in their tightening grip.

These are the revelations of the Water-Bearer, where open air condenses into outpouring water. The void is the vessel of creation and containment of what's openly received, what naturally enters through the lack of force, that which may thence be poured out for everyone and everything, enriching all in reciprocal accord with natural law. The more open and expansive the vessel, the more that it may contain, the more that may be poured into it, the greater the wealth of Spirit which that vessel may pour into life. For, as Lao Tzu instructed, The Way is as the dwelling and the river. The most important part of the dwelling isn't the walls and roof, but the negative space within in which life is lived. The ability to change forms and move throughout the world through the path of least resistance is the most important part of the river. So it is with the Water-Bearer, those through whom the open, receiving vessel, the air, the vacant dwelling, meets the releasing, fertilizing river, where the condensing water pours itself into the roots.

And so it is with the breath, a symbol of the Water-Bearer, and the balancing of Being. Take Spirit in, let Spirit out. What we receive always equals what we give, even when we're unaware of this undercurrent flowing beneath the easily-perceivable surface. We're always most capable of giving when we've received the most, and are only best able to receive when we've emptied ourselves. Gradually are the subtle emanations of the Cosmic Mind gathered by the purest, most open perceivers, condensed into the unadulterated truth, poured out to those open enough to receive them. This is the holy task of the Water-Bearer, to receive as pure a stream from the Source as possible, unpolluted by prejudice and preconception, poured out to cleanse and fertilize a humanity swamped with unclean waters muddied by every prideful pretense of the truth.

The Dawning Prophecy

The Fabric Can't Be Torn

The whole of humanity hinges upon the difference between symbiosis and parasitism; between the objective of extracting as much as possible for exclusionary benefit and adding as much as possible for inclusionary benefit.

So long have we been trained to worship the ways of the parasite that they've been stained into our social fabric, a fabric wrapped around us from the moment that we can speak and think, so tightly and for so long that they've become embedded in every fiber of that fabric, interlaced with the minds of those thereby swaddled and swindled. It has reached the point where only the discerning few can see those stains, with most assuming that they're not just embedded in OUR fabric, but constitute THE fabric; that they're the *only* reality, intertwined with our inescapable nature of the strong eating the weak, the basis of 'realism.'

But that's NOT the only reality, and that's NOT our inescapable nature. Rather, it's what we've been conditioned by the corrupted to become. We can and WILL enter the next stage of our evolution by riding the natural, stain-cleansing tide of progressive ideas, systems and tools while breaking the dam currently retaining that tide, a dam built upon a habituated misunderstanding of simple, fundamental words like 'freedom,' 'democracy,' 'worth,'

'success' and 'God.' As Emerson noted: "The corruption of man is followed by the corruption of language." And the course of human history is beset by the effects of this corruption, as that history is marked by the powerfully corrupt directing humankind away from our best interests through the Orwellian art of propaganda; the darkly deceptive practice that purposefully pushes us to misunderstand words and their connected ideas, turning what should be empowering, uniting understanding into disempowering, divisive misunderstanding, the majority successfully trained to speak lies as though speaking the truth; to blindly craft their own cages as though constructing their castles. This is, of course, by design, for remaining inside the cage depends upon our not seeing it. And it takes the vision, understanding, courage and compassion of the idealist to see and reveal the means to break the dams holding us back; dams that the masses aren't even aware exist, because they've been built to be invisible, for only the dams that can be denied will last.

It takes the progressive champion to see the systemic parasitism, and to possess the conviction and moral imperative to show it to others, the first step in humanity's emancipation; to reveal it in our exploitative leases, mortgages, wages and salaries taking advantage of the non-possession of equity, making most akin to servants to the owning overlords; in our fake, pre-sold democracy directed by the shareholders of multinational corporations pushing for global expansion under the guise of spreading freedom and democracy; in our stock markets rewarding

the biggest, most ruthless parasites demonstrating the greatest ability to suck as much value as possible from the people and the planet, imperiling the system through which they feed with absolute, bailed-out impunity; in our credit and debt enslaving us to the almighty dollar, perpetuated by our conditioned consumerism; in divided-and-conquered sold as 'individualism,' in no-holds-barred, prey-on-the-weak jungle law sold as 'freedom,' in those whose rippling global actions make for the most misery in the world called 'successful,' and in unsustainable, humanity-oppressing greed sold as 'worth;' in unnatural chemical concoctions that turn patrons into debilitated dependents sold as 'medicine' by glorified drug dealers who've stolen the designation of 'doctor,' with the real medicine sitting in neglected gardens; in addictive, inflammatory poisons with insidiously-accruing costs sold as 'food,' causing the chronic conditions keeping us conveniently chained to those same 'doctors' whilst the real food waits to be seeded in those same neglected gardens; in 'therapists' inventing new, stigmatizing, boxing-in diagnostic labels to adhere to the suffering so that they can be turned into zombied-out patrons of another type of glorified, drug-dealing 'doctor' whilst 'magic mushrooms' and myriad other true, naturally-evolved medicines remain either illegal, or called 'alternative treatments,' even though they've been used successfully for millennia, usually without dependency or side-effects (which the abhorrently profitable, people-taxing, parasitic 'medical industry' can't stand, because they can't be owned); in our

religions turning the most empowering, inclusive, uniting of all things, spirituality, into disempowerment, exclusion and division based upon millennia of evolving propaganda plugged into the parasitic partnership of Church and State.

In total, unrestrained capitalism NOT balanced by socialistic virtues has turned humanity into whores; into divided and conquered extractors, hoarders and cutthroats of our fellow brothers and sisters, forever under siege and enslaved by the hoarders of the most capital, fighting for the right to survive, with very, very few having any real opportunity to discover what it's like to THRIVE. Excepting very select sectors of the public service economy, every human being is forced by socioeconomic circumstance to seek-out the best possible means to profit off of his or her fellow human beings, and the plundered planet at large.

This perpetual state of survivalist pressure, the people holding up the gargantuan weight of the parasites, creates a constant state of winner-eat-loser division and cold, cruel contention that kills solidarity, cooperation and communal concern, all the means and modes of mutualistic symbiosis, and instead forces us into a system of frenzied economic fighting and consumeristic feeding in which most people unwittingly play the prey, all whilst the excluding minority at the top of the frenzy, those whose forebears built the system and have spent centuries adapting it to the pushback of progressive champions, are the lording leeches whom our prevailing system of values teaches us to lionize. We're raised to look up to the fattest leeches,

glorifying them as the winners with the most ‘worth,’ when in fact they’re of NEGATIVE WORTH to life because they cost FAR more to life and the planet than they create.

It’s disturbingly ironic that Ponzi and Pyramid Schemes are considered criminal, for the dirty little secret known only to the observant, critically-thinking few is that it’s ALL one big Pyramid Scheme. It’s as if ninety-five-percent of us are trapped in one big casino, playing the house, in games rigged to beat us, all the parades and waving flags of ‘freedom’ like the hypnosis of slot machines. And not only does this systemic FACT make most of us divided and conquered enemies of one another, and does this, in turn, decimate brotherhood and goodwill, but it locks us into being lifelong, stressed-out servants of our own oppression, and complicit in the decimation of our planet. We not only can do better, we MUST do better, as every day the gap between the haves and have-nots grows wider by the very nature of greed and wealth consolidation, the Human Spirit and the planet both degraded in the process.

Under the divine guidance of psilocybin I’ve had my own epiphany that the greater part of the malaise, the heaving, burdensome, miserable weight which I’ve carried throughout my adult life, is an effect of this cause of being forced to serve the systems of my own oppression, and that of my brethren. I’ve felt the weight, and the rising indignation, of these invisible burdens since my mind made of me a philosopher. I’ve realized that I’ve ALWAYS been writing about casting off this yoke, about jettisoning

the dead weight which most of us carry on behalf of our bloated masters, those whom sit, concealed and invisible, upon the shoulders of the people. Everyone feels the weight, even as few see and understand its causality.

Casting off the invisible yoke has been the core subject of my writing since my first book, *Infinite of One*, about a small, spiritually-seeking, self-sufficient community in the redwoods where I was raised; a community made by a facsimile of me whom, above all else, fights to see and break the binds of the euphemistically-cited 'upper class;' the owners of humankind; the inheritors of the long-evolving ways and means of the conquering subjugators. And it's only by cutting the cords binding me to their obesity, and casting them off of my body and mind, that I can know lasting freedom and peace; and only by serving the same function for my brethren may I be at one with my divine purpose; with the reason God has granted me the simultaneous gift and burden of my discriminating sight.

Do you see it as well? Do you see, or on some level *sense*, that we must summon the strength and unity to break the shackles of our systemic oppression? However, in order to do so, we must first help others to SEE the shackles, for, again, none may be spurred to break cages and shackles, dams and dividing fences, if they can't see them. We've been called upon to help those blind to this truth, even as they dismiss us, or, kicking and screaming, call us enemies.

This mission is what my writing is about: showing the shackles to those who can't see them, and who hate me

for doing so. And only by casting them off, by emancipating and moving our minds from how best to take advantage to how best to add mutual advantage, may we exit The Age of Empire and enter The Age of Aquarius. This long-time-incoming, painful transition in what MLK famously called “the long bending arc of the moral universe” is inseparable from a mass spiritual awakening, which shall fuse itself with the progressive social systems which, together, as one force, shall usher in The Dawning. We’re coming into the age in which we rediscover our inseparability from not only one another, but from the purely energetic Universal Consciousness which forms the basis of reality and life’s inseparability from divinity, a truth that religion has buried, separating us from God and leading us away from truth.

For if we accept that God may never fit into or be controlled by any single religion, for It’s the pure, indestructible energy of Universal Consciousness, then we must come to see that everything in existence IS this Universal Consciousness; that we dwell within and are intertwined with this Everything; that separation is an illusion of sensory limitation, and that ALL forms of consciousness are intertwined with THE Consciousness. And with everything being a facet of this one Universal Consciousness, the one perfect, interminable white light shining through endless uniquely-shaped sides of the prism of matter made from the condensing of indestructibly-pure spiritual energy (Spirit), so it is that each of those sides may alter its very shape, and the manner in which the white light shining through it is

projected upon the world of forms which it, WE, forever reform by most purely conducting the One Consciousness.

We're inseparable from God, and, thus, inseparable from the eternal reformation; we need only sense and harness this natural law in order to become what we will. The Light Chose the Darkness

Why the Immortal One Became Infinite Mortality

We can never know true freedom as human beings, because we're born into a bondage chosen by our source Self, aka 'God.' For true freedom is to: (1) be invulnerable (2) be subject to no one and nothing, unless desired, and (3) have no need. That part of you for which these qualities don't exist is thus bound by their absence, defining your relative lack of freedom. No self can know otherwise.

For the divine secret is that perfect freedom is a misery that mortals can never know, and that some bonds are necessary in order to avoid the absolute misery of an existence devoid of meaning and value BECAUSE it's singular and everlasting. It's a particular mode of existential suffering that mortals are incapable of, having been gifted its absence in the trade with mortality.

We can scarcely conceive of suffering singularism, much less experience or understand it. Can you conceive of existing as the one and only thing in existence? Can you conceive of never beginning, and having no end? Can you conceive of space being relative only to that which exists in one constrained area of spacetime, and big banging space in order to allow an infinity of your oneness? Can you conceive of matter only mattering as a means to exist in

spacetime? To be divine is to be of an all-composing-and-encompassing, pure, irreducible energy that needs not matter nor spacetime nor sustenance nor egotistic conception to survive. The One made Itself infinite in order to escape an eternity of oneness. It made Itself into the means for infinite forms of formlessness because It was lonely. Thus It gave birth to the existential basis of infinite forms of Its formlessness, so that it could be together with endless forms of Itself, the limitless variance of uniformity.

Divinity is to be both beyond as well as the source of spacetime, energy and matter, the source and inspiration of all creation that isn't subject to anything or anyone, including destruction. Our freedom as mortal beings is thus known relative to our closeness to God. All sense of vulnerability, everything that we believe that we need, and all forces, persons and institutions to which we're subject (including our own egotistic, illusory ideas of ourselves in suffering the delusion of our independence), everything that pulls us outside the ceaseless central eye of the storm of selfhood into the ceaselessly recycling, violent vortex of endless reformation and redefinition of self, is the burdensome basis of our bondage (our non-freedom). It's ironic that most people fear death as though it's an ending when we were made for the *value* of ending.

And yet love is the greatest vulnerability of all, and is the revelation of the bridge between the self and the Self: the part of the Self that's most innate to and immanent within every self. It's the evocation of oneness forever underlying the illusion of plurality; the Base of Being. Thus the answer to the great paradoxical mystery of existence: the Self, God, choosing to bind Itself to selfhood so as to appreciate Its existence. Life is only sweet, and we only fear to be deprived of it, and we only cling to and value it BECAUSE it ends. Mythologically, every immortal seeks their mortality.

Spacetime and matter are Self-impositions imposed for the sake of making existence invaluable through the quality of being broken into finite fragments of endless variance and perspective of being that end relative to themselves, to the self, as infinite facets of an eternal, indestructible Self. So we find that infinity has no value without the finite; that mortality grants immortality meaning; that death is the redemption of life; that pain and suffering potentiate

pleasure and ecstasy. The light CHOSE the darkness,
without which it has no value, no quality, no purpose, only
the white light of the singularity with nowhere to shine.

The Kingdom of Heaven

Not One Can be Estranged

Any truth spoken by anyone, even *thought* by anyone, didn't come from them. They aren't the source; none of us are the source of anything. Rather, as revealed by history, by the retroactivity of every social and physical science, by the philosophical axiom that separation is an illusion, by Faulkner's "the past is never dead, it's not even the past," by *The Matrix's* "causality is the one real truth," by physics' "nothing is created or destroyed, only forever rearranged," which I believe to be a *metaphysical* truth, by the fact that beginnings and endings are illusions, by General Relativity's revelation of time being a largely illusory *concept* based upon the perception of something 'passing' only to those who aren't themselves passing at the extent of passage, we, as seemingly independent beings, aren't the *source* of anything. We're merely material and mental conduits of truths that always have existed and always will exist, and our ability to recognize, speak and record those truths is limited only by our mental, linguistic and technological capacities of Source into self, or Self into Its infinitely re-manifesting selves, Energy into Mother Matter.

This is why my imprint is called *Infinite of One*: it's all one thing of infinite variance, the metaphysical construct of pure energy into spacetime and matter made so that God,

the grandest possible We, the one and only Source, could experience that Source Self from infinite possible vantage points. So when I say something that your heart, the entry point of the infinite into the finite, immediately recognizes as true, it's because I'm acting as an accurate translator of something that has *always* been true. There's no truth that hasn't always been the truth. It's but a matter of your inner prophet speaking an eternal truth received from, and conducted by, the infinite atop which every singular sits.

By the way, in case you're unaware of it, the secret, ironic purpose of science is actually to *reveal* God; to demonstrate the perfect interconnection underlying the illusion of disconnection, just as the secret purpose of evil, or the Devil, is to reveal good, or God, just as to be forever blinded by the Great White Light is to see nothing, such that only by the darkness can the purpose and power of the light be known. We're infinite of finite form in order to uncover and fully appreciate the One of formless infinity. And that formless One that is our essence is deathless.

The common misconception that we 'go' somewhere when we die is as much based upon thinking within the temporal, spatial and material constraints of our current being as it is a vestige of religious indoctrination of believing in divisible souls ushered into damnation or heavenly emancipation. When you have the sense of God that I do, as unconstrained by space, time or matter, as the all-encompassing Self of which all self is an inseparable manifestation, you know that dying itself is an illusion, as

all 'ends' are actually unending reabsorptions into the Everything to which everything and everyone belongs.

And by the same token, if you think that I'm writing this, or *anything* that I've written, under my own, 'independent' volition, as if concocted on a coconut-covered island untouched by the surrounding Sea of Source, you're wrong; you're victimized by the same illusion of individualism that the conquerors and oppressors use to keep us divided and conquered. Alas, even *they* shall be seen to have served our unification in the end, like a rubber band that can only stretch so far before snapping back into the center by the equal and opposite forces compelling existence, just as all of nature, all of God's manifestations, even the meteorological phenomena that wire the planet together, are set in service to equilibrium. Just as anything which anyone may come to see in me or anyone else which is truly worthy of reverence isn't of *me*, but of that which, or whom, I may come to ably *embody*.

This, in turn, alludes to the evil of idolatry, an evil prevalent in what Empire has made of the lessons of those hailed as prophets for the purposes of controlling the minds of the misled believer; lessons which are antithetical to the true purpose and power of spirituality: that *anyone* may think and speak prophetically, it's but a matter of tapping into and accurately translating the forever prophetic Source. Spirit, or God, is the infusing force within us *all*, even the most arrogant atheist and the most reductive realist. God is the connective tissue which we all experience as love. To

pretend as though God belongs to any limited subset of life, much less one person conveniently kept in the past, forever removed from critical analysis, is to disempower anyone whom believes it, keeping them on their knees, powerless to be who, or *what*, they most truly are, in allusion to AA's Christian "I'm a powerless alcoholic or addict" edict and, indeed, alluding to religion in general.

God didn't manifest you to be some God-damned automaton, some reflexively obedient drone nodding your head in a Church that's no different than any other space, any other edifice, whether made of brick and mortar or mountain or river or towering trees, in its conduciveness to channeling the divine force. Where love and its enlivening force are most present, so is divinity. And God made you to quest after divinity *through* doubt; to seek the truth buried in the lies borne by a history of Church and State made to conceal it. Don't fear your doubt, or see it as a 'lack of faith,' as the priest ignobly trains you to do, out of his fear that you may gain the ability to see through him and gaze upon the divinity that surrounds you at all times, in all places. Rather, delve *deeper* into the doubt. Rather than run from what the false representatives of God goad you into believing are the heretical inquiries of heathenism, cast yourself into the cyclonic cataclysm of confusion that'll eventually suck you into the elucidating center of the Spirit. And through Spirit is all moral truth revealed.

Do you want to know the most consistent manner by which I know that America is the land of divided and

conquered, a land in which only communalism (which we're conditioned to associate with the tyrannies confused with socialistic states) can save the people? My apartment complex, and being a pedestrian; someone who loves to walk. That is, we victims of systematic oppression accepted as 'normal' walk right by one another here, every day, day after drudgery-stricken day, and say *nothing* to one another, usually not even looking one another in the eye, as though everyone is an 'other,' and, thus, of no relevance to us whatsoever, and essentially nonexistent. What waste!

I don't know a single person outside my own unit in this sprawling complex, one in which the socioeconomics at play necessarily disturbs anyone even the *least* bit aware and progressive, possessing even the *slightest* sense of the oppressive implications imposed upon its residents flushing thousands of dollars down the proverbial tubes stretching across the entirety of the economic landscape through leases and wages representing little more than barely surviving whilst feeding the parasitism that embodies this morally-bankrupt nation. One of my housemates walks right by me every day without saying a word to me! And he lives with me! I have to forcefully wrangle him into even the briefest of conversations.

He's a twenty-something self-described 'realist' who's really a jaded pessimist working multiple jobs for the chance to improve that depressingly narrow perspective upon the 'one and only reality.' And we're 'the most advanced nation on Earth.' Advancing towards *what*,

exactly? I implore you to ask yourself that question. And to consider the *only* salvation: *communal investment*. We can only beat the parasites by pooling our energy and resources, and no, that doesn't necessitate communism, or even socialism. It necessitates collective forms of mutually financed equity creation. Such as through collective investments in massive mortgage funds that permit us to acquire the land to build tiny home communities for first time and other low income buyers, and thereby build ownership through collective buying power instead of just enriching the wealthy at our expense. *Own, or be owned!*

The amount of money the over-lording leeching equity owners of this complex suck out of disadvantaged people every *month*, much less every year, is astoundingly disturbing. And yet ninety-nine percent of those that I mention this to *immediately* close themselves off from me, landing somewhere between 'pinko commie bastard!' and 'there's nothing we can do about it, Nick, so why waste our time and energy getting all stressed out about the entirely inescapable reality,' the 'realism' of the law of the jungle. In truth, much of what's assumed the one reality is, in fact, an *artificial* reality created to feed off of us, and its blood-sucking serpents slither across every sector of our society. Speaking of jungle realism, Neo-Darwinism predicts a frightening fate for the future of selectively-bred humanity.

Integrity is being bred out of the human race, in a secret and very real manifestation of Darwin's 'survival of the fittest (which actually means survival of those best *fitted* to

their environments, not the most physically fit, in case you're unaware),' for the simple reason that *it isn't profitable*. More than that, in truth: integrity actually interferes with the profit motive, which isn't actually based upon anything but exploiting the disadvantages and insufficiencies of protection of the people and the planet as consumers, workers and resource-rich regions of the environment. Wherewithal never comes from *nowhere*. It's all one causal string; one immense financial food chain.

Profiteers don't 'make money,' in but one of an endless string of propagandist, euphemistic phrases interwoven through society to suit the capitalist value system. Rather, they *take* it from people and places lower on the food chain, then disguise that extraction as if they're doing a favor to those thereby exploited and oppressed. Yes, there's a usually a value provided by the commodity (product or service), but the profit margin itself is paid by the buyer, worker and the planet *to* an exclusive equity-holding, ever-narrower slice of the population that typically isn't providing the value, but whom merely owns and capitalizes upon the commodity. Which is why my motto is 'equity or exploitation.' If you don't hold equity in a profitable enterprise that you're in any way involved with, *you're* one of the people, places or things being profited off of. To be aware of the unjust nature of these depredations is to possess integrity, and thus *not* to fit the unnatural modern mode of the profiteers and their minions. Hence, 'survival of the fittest' for the human race has devolved to mean 'fitting the profit motive,' which, in

turn, rewards those *lacking* integrity, all the way up to the level of the megalomaniacal sociopathy of our president.

In fact, *honor*, a forgotten word except among the militant who use it dishonorably to point to the tip of the sword of globalization wielded on behalf of the fattest plutocratic leeches, is, in reality, such a rare quality in modern America that we elected Chump to play president. Surely this is as much an indication of the gradually-descending apocalypse as anything else. Those whom, by their integrity, much less their honor, resist this Neo-Darwinian dominance are literally being bred out of humanity, as they're *unfit* to compete with the parasites running the race; parasites protected by so much deeply ingrained propaganda that few come anywhere near to *seeing* it, let alone fighting it. The good guys have little chance with the ladies when competing with the wealth-extractors, their progeny thus voided as 'too soft' for the cutthroat jungle.

The only way that the good guy may compete for the future of a saved human race following his lead is to spread the good word, which starts with seeing through propaganda. So it's imperative that those whom seek the spiritual truth, and the political and economic truth, *all* interwoven truth, really, learn to see through the tricks of the deceivers cloaked in the garments of godliness. Failing this, they become silent victims of demons in divine dress; snakes denouncing the *legitimate* soothsayers as snakes. Most often the snakes don't even know that they don scales, for so well have the indoctrinations of propaganda

been preserved in training manuals that those whom become snakes adorn the skin of the snake unwittingly, and unconsciously pass on the venom of age-old masters of mind control pushing the prey along from aristocracy to aristocracy via theology, politics, business and economics.

The spiritual reality, that we're infinite finite forms of the same One, infinite, formless being, God, is buried beneath the fabricated economic truth and religious lies of our being 'individuals;' of our being mere workers and wealth-amassers cutthroat-competing with one another for the limited wherewithal available in the world at any one time, and possessors of individual 'souls' fated for everlasting torment or salvation. We're slaves to financial and theological masters whom, ironically, embody the 'father of lies' which they call *me* for telling you the truth, as they have countless times before, especially via the '*Meta*' platforms (Meta! Ha! What perfect propaganda, what an exemplary example of the deceiver adorning robes of righteousness, for that business interest best representing the *disconnection* of the digital avatar that filters out true, natural human connection, the anti-socialism of social media, the surface level pretense of connection inhibiting the true unity at the Base of Being, the *authentic* Meta, to call *itself* Meta!). Me! Seemingly the only one who knows the foundation of true morality, a form of the Golden Rule that I've called the Spiritual Rule since I finished my first book some fifteen years ago or more: *Treat everyone as a version of yourself, because that's what they actually are.*

I'm still attempting to enforce this spiritual realization in my daily life, but I stand by the humbling-yet-empowering truth of it. In *Eyeless in Gaza*, Huxley reminds me that how we regard others is what we tend to find in them, because it's what we're looking for, and that the language we use to describe them in our minds we thereby come to confirm. Look for the qualities catapulting, and the language conducive to, goodness and progress, he seems to suggest. Towards the end of the book, one character, feeling superior, regards people as 'bugs,' another regards them as 'men,' and both of them find what they're looking for: the qualities of tininess, and the qualities of manhood. Both are potentially present in *everyone*, and yet they both see and tend to bring out of others what they project onto them. It's a powerful lesson that I understand, but that I've yet been unable to master in the constant conflicts of life.

For me, if I'm being honest, I find that I carry around this continuous contempt for humanity, so *that's* what I find: contemptible qualities; an enduring evil of misandrist manifestation. I've come to realize that I adore nature, and so abhor unnaturality. For the same reason I adore every human heart, but hate the common human mind, for it's fallen prey to the unnatural divides that're taught to us as though they *are* reality, when the only reality that they truly constitute is the setting of the stage for our division and exploitation. And so it is that my relationship with my fellow embodiments of Being, with *beings*, is love-hate.

It's extremely difficult for me to integrate my knowledge of Spirit with the knowledge of those contemporaries of mine whom always seem so unaware of Its truths. I know that I must continue to practice my spirituality in my regard for others, and that *that's* my test, as it is for all of us. I must practice non-otherness until otherness fades. I need to see the unifying truth in everyone, *especially* when they fail to portray it, taught to disregard and dishonor that truth from the first *Pledge of Allegiance* to all the overlording lies that rule them (the conquerors want you to believe that we're *one nation, under God, indivisible*, so that you'll confuse the unifying truth of God with the plutocratic lies that *actually* control the country, caring nothing for unity whatsoever, for unification interferes with the excluding aims of greed and ego of whom they *truly* serve: *Satan*). I need the proper language, the ideal regard, the perfect gesture. For example, I was once told me that "Namaste" is defined as "the divine in me bows to the divine in you."

While the dictionary defines Namaste as simply "I bow to you," I like it either way, especially the first way, and mean to practice it in my regard for others, even for the dishonorable dividers, the flag-waving, conservative tribalists unwittingly carrying the battle standard of Satan into the One War. For, if you don't realize that the entire globalizing world is set in service to greed, your head is buried in the sand. You've been duped. If you don't realize that every idea proffered by every conservative politician is a lie made to conceal this one single, salient truth, that crooks run the country in order to steal as much as they

can, always calling it something else, like ‘freedom’ and ‘democracy,’ you’re a pawn being played by the powerful. And while I can’t erase the contemptible within those that fail such realization, thereby following every lie concocted to serve greed, I might be able to mitigate it, whilst also finding my own peace of mind. With regard to enlisting the proper language in my mind for that regard, I must learn to regard each of you, dear readers, not as ‘people,’ or as ‘individuals,’ but as something similar to the first namaste. As ‘the beings of Being,’ perhaps. As the ones of the One.

“Separate patterns, but everywhere alike. Everywhere the same constellations of the ultimate units of energy ... identically complex (patterns) through vast ranges of animate being... Each organism is unique. Unique and yet united with all other organisms in the sameness of its ultimate parts (Huxley; *Eyeless in Gaza*).” We must learn to communicate that universality, that spiritual foundation of shared essential Self, any way we can, including physically. For what is ‘sex,’ and especially ‘fucking,’ but a debasing of the act of intertwining inseparability at the Base of Being?; a corruption of the incorruptible act of truly ‘making love.’ It reminds me of the power of simple gestures, or ‘body language’ expressions, that I like; including, yes, practicing the art of physically-expressing intimacy, but also bowing the head, and/or holding the arms out wide, hands palm up; gestures of love and respect and peace and offering, not dissimilar to the feudal derivation of the handshake coming from showing one’s open hand to those whom one approached to demonstrate that a weapon wasn’t being

held, and that they come in peace. All expressions of our being equal parts of God are the critical communications.

Unlike those whom you've been trained to revere, I seek *not* to glorify my vanity in building up yet another towering compensation for insecurity, but to embody a very different ambition: to wipe away the occluding pestilence encrusted upon the seal set between you and the well-springing Source of all things; to give that Source back to the Source-bearers whom have been deprived that spiritual right by the religious oppressors; to purify the waters, and play my part in ushering in the Age of Aquarius, whether you believe that to be a delusion or not. For, though I may seem irrelevant to some, and sometimes fall into such a despairing impression myself, in my moments of clarity I find that I'm right in the middle of the war for our world, because I have the ability to wage that war on a foundational level of universal spiritual principle.

With that in mind, permit me to tell you a secret, ye whom have been mercilessly mangled by the modern realists:

Anything that has energy has everlasting life. And everything has energy. It's past, present and future tense in everything, for the totality of time.

Thus do I know that I've always been, and that it's only the forms of me that rearrange to fit the evolving conditions of the entirety of existence. Matter was made and strewn across spacetime so that we may know the Self by seeing

Self from every possible vantage point, including yours.
The whole of the Body of Being is being explored by being.

The Traceless Walker

I bid you know the traceless walker, that wanders through your every space. That knows you like a memory that time cannot erase. For I have come to you again, though you know me not. Together shall we remember, all for which they fought. Their death regrows as thistles, they spur into my sides. I heed the voiceless whisper of my omnipresent spies. I need not your obedience, the golden treasure of the fooled. I need you to be the thread through which the sacrament was spooled. So adorn your holy raiment, for it belongs to each and all, and behold as Babylon's besieging towers fall. The plundered take is for the embodied to make what was denied the embodied at birth. To learn the truth of our divine design, that God is what we're worth.

Everyone has a prophet in their hearts, dear reader, it's all a matter of the makeup of their bodies and especially their minds, as to how much and how clear the divine signal received, and how well they're able to translate that signal. Thus, I would suggest to you that those whom become what others call 'prophets' owes not to their particular qualities as individualized persons, as gods or demigods to be worshipped above anyone else, but to their capacity to channel the force of God more purely than others. That is, they become prophets because they embody the best receptacle for God to speak *through* them, not because

they are, in and of themselves, any more divine than anyone else, or, worse, the one and only 'Son of God.' It's a matter of those of sufficient expansiveness of vessel, and clarity of channel, to best receive and pour out the divine truths. That, and possessing of sufficient self-belief to inspire the mutually-empowering belief of the people.

The Kingdom of Heaven

The Kingdom of Heaven is within as much as it is without. Just as body and mind are born by eternal seed of hearted sprout. Just as salt dissolves into water, and cannot be observed. Just as time envelopes space, and is by energy conserved. Just as what separates you from me are but materialist illusions. And every ego bids the self to give into individualist delusions. For all of life adorns the dress sewn from a single spool. And all division is made by masks masqueraded by every fool. As it matters less how the skin is painted, how the patterns are arranged. And matters more that from our oneness not one can be estranged.

We Are Infinite of One

The Five Fundamental Laws of Existence

There's a spiritual secret of existence to which all of us are subject regardless of our relative awareness of it, and even as the prevailing human systems act in opposition to it:

There's no way to push others down without pushing yourself down, and there's no way to lift others up without lifting yourself up. For the instant reciprocity of Spirit is such that otherness is an illusion, and, therefore, anything done to the illusive 'other' is done to oneself.

(1) Outside of theory and its conceptions, there is no such thing as nothing, as the complete absence of all things, as the real existence of zero, such as the nonexistence of all energy, matter and spacetime; considering the interrelated laws of physics and philosophical logic, nothingness is an impossibility that contradicts the very nature of existence.

(2) Nothing that 'is' can be derived from 'nothing;' that is, everything that exists outside of the mind in matter or its purer, essential energetic pre-formation within the dimensions of spacetime must come from something else that materially or energetically exists or existed; from another 'real' thing, as opposed to being derived from a nonexistent thing, or a non-thing, on an unreal thing,

because no thing that is may be derived from a thing that isn't. For anything from or times nothing, or zero, is nothing and, therefore, nothing cannot constitute a beginning or a continuation of anything. For the same reason there can be no beginning or end of anything, only a change in the structure and distribution of the thing.

(3) Per the previous point, nothing that materially or energetically exists may be created or destroyed, only broken down into a more fundamental, or 'basic,' set of constituents, then redistributed, rearranged or otherwise combined with other compatible constituents to form one or more 'new' thing(s); 'new' thing(s) which, by the same reasoning and logic, can never truly be *new*, only amalgamations of what existed prior to their formation.

(4) All matter is composed of energy and, therefore, everything that exists is ultimately made up of energy, not of matter, for matter requires great energy to create and maintain mass and material form (as evidenced by, in one clear, dramatic example, the energy released upon splitting an atom), but energy does not require matter and may exist without a measurable mass, as it is with photons.

(5) Everything is connected by cause and effect (causality). Everything that exists and occurs does so because it was caused to exist or occur along the subsequent spacetime continuum as an effect of all preceding, interconnected contributing causes, which are typically beyond count. There truly *is* a reason for everything that exists and happens: the forever accumulating, interconnected effects

of causes within spacetime. Most of these causes and effects, and their formative forces of interrelation, remain unnoticed and unmeasured, creating the illusion of 'randomness,' or 'chaos.' The revelation, measurement and understanding of the interrelated causality of these forms and forces points to the advent and progression of the discipline generally known as 'science;' the discipline of measuring the relative distinction and interrelation of composing forms and forces of the irreducible One Thing.

What Does This All Mean?

From these five fundamental laws we see that everything that exists has always existed and always will exist, for it cannot have come from a non-thing and cannot be created or destroyed. There has always been everything, and there can never be anything less than everything. Every uniquely manifested form of energy or condensing of energy into matter that exists, ever has existed and ever will exist, including every uniquely, finitely existing form of body and brain conducting consciousness must necessarily exist as a unique arrangement of and interaction between constituents ultimately composed of the original source; the first cause: the premiere, irreducible energetic basis of all things, including every form of being born into matter.

Furthermore, and in consideration of the aforementioned laws, tracing this energetic basis of existence reductively back along the spacetime continuum dictates that this first cause must have been a source of incomprehensively

powerful energy of the purest possible form (a form which cannot be further reduced to one or more forms which are more basic, or fundamental) which caused the chain of causality leading to every individualized manifestation of itself. All things exist as relative concentrations and arrangements of the first thing, including the dimensions of spacetime dictating the relative relationships of energy.

Therefore, everything and everyone that exists, or that has existed or will exist, must be composed entirely of the original, eternal source of the purest, irreducible energy, differentiated only by the concentration and arrangement of that energy and the point in spacetime in which that energy is concentrated in its current composition and relationship with other compositions, all existing within the all-inclusive source itself. Paraphrasing Einstein, the purpose of spacetime is so that everything doesn't occur simultaneously, in the same time and space; this is but one of *many* examples of science accidentally proving Spirit.

Thus, the existential purpose of spacetime is to potentiate infinite possible forms of the existence of the same source limitlessly rearranged such that the original source of energy may be infinitely divided into relatively unique existences, all occurring *within* that source, none occurring in the same time or space as any other. Dimension permits the division of one source, what humanity commonly calls God, or Spirit, into infinite forms of Itself and experiences of its limitless potential interactions, concentrations and formations; the existential canvas painted with living truth.

Therefore, we all exist as individualized forms of the original, eternal, purest possible source of energy that set into motion the chain of causality leading to every subsequent version of itself painted across the existential canvas of spacetime. And, therefore, everything that exists must be a transitory arrangement of the eternal, unending energy source of all things, and everything that happens must exist as a cumulative cause set-off by the original cause: the expansion of the One, Spirit, into the building blocks of the infinitely many: the distribution of energy which, under certain conditions, is condensed into matter which, under yet rarer, requisite, hospitable conditions, is forever redeveloped into the building blocks of life through the intelligently adaptive coding known *natural evolution*.

Indeed, all things in existence must exist only as *relative* differentiations, entirely dependent upon, within, and as versions of the Spirit composing and encompassing all things; the one constant, constantly being rearranged, with spacetime existing as a means to differentiate between unique versions of this no-possible-beginning, no-possible-end, omnipresent essence of everything in Its existence.

For all the same interdependent reasons there can be no division between and individual possession of a 'soul,' or separating individual essence, as traditionally understood and disseminated by religious institutions through their corruption and ownership by Empire. Instead, and informed by broad historical trends and prevailing motives, this must be viewed as a historically-pervasive means of

mentally manipulating the minds and actions of adherents through the typical fear-based coercions of punishment, reward and peer pressure to which all limited, relatively ignorant minds and needing, paining and pleasing bodies are susceptible. In truth, all things and all people are made of the same essence and share the same 'soul:' Spirit.

The concept of the soul does, itself, actually represent a form of *spiritual egotism*. This is, of course, a contradiction in terms; the apotheosis of the oxymoron. For there's no such thing as any true ownership of or distinction in Spirit, in God; anything that says otherwise, *including* the concept of the separable soul, is, in fact, antithetical to the all-encompassing, all-embodying nature of Being into being. Your essence, just like the essence of all, is Spirit, and Spirit is the purest, irreducible point of energy producing and pervading all spacetime and Its material amassment into seemingly separable beings. Thus, to believe in a separable 'soul' belonging only to you, detached from the One that's the essence of everything, is to be not only deluded and conned by the divide and conquer imperialism that concocted the concept of the soul in order to control the people through their gullibility and need for acceptance, but is also to be horrendously disempowered and divided from one's fellow holy incarnations, and owned by Empire.

Only our minds, bodies and experiences of life are differentiable and unique, existing as compositions of the perfectly ubiquitous building block. This is the very purpose of One into Infinite of One: endless unique

experience of the One by the One existing as the infinitely, endlessly-evolving many 'fitting' their local spacetime placement. And even with this individualized uniqueness there's *far* more fundamental commonality across all biological forms of life than there are differences, including the inseparable, indivisible essence and core spiritual identity of all life, aka 'Spirit,' or the 'Big Self,' and all the emotional capacities and motivations born of that Self.

Therefore, any conception of the nature of existence or of its source, whether you call this God, Spirit or otherwise, which in any way excludes or is said to be absolutely separate from anything or anyone else that exists is inherently false, illogical and prone to perpetuating evil idea and action by way of its unnecessary divisions of identity and all the conflicts, exclusions and loss of solidarity and collaboration subsequently spurred through the spreading and acceptance of such divisive conceptions. Any version of identity that fails to recognize that it is fundamentally inseparable from all other identities and, thus, perfectly inclusionary and non-absolute, is equally unnecessarily false, divisive and potentiating of evil effect.

In the core of our truest, irreducible, essential shared Self, there is but one identity. This is, of course, why the Buddhists distinguish between the 'small self' (the egotistic identity that thinks and acts upon the delusional self-importance of separation) and the 'Big Self' (the spiritual identity that knows that separation is ultimately an illusion), why the Rastafarians say "I and I," alluding to the

physical self *hosting* the spiritual Self, why the non-dualistic concept overlapping what I once called monoexistentialism goes back thousands of years, to the roots of Hindu, Buddhist and Taoist beliefs and their most sacred texts, and why spiritual philosophers tend to identify the ego, the self-perception and self-conception inherent to material, individualized existence and its illusion of self-separation, as the core cause of all evil.

Were we *not* to see this separation and, instead, see and act based upon every life being a version of the same life, the same inseparable identity of Spirit, no absolute separation of identity and evil action would exist, for we'd see that doing evil to any 'other' is doing evil to Self. It is for this reason that the protagonist of my first work, the philosophical novel *Infinite of One*, hits upon the concept of The Spiritual Rule: Treat everyone as you would have them treat you because, ultimately, *they ARE you*.

We're all versions of The One. We're *Infinite of One*.

The Ubiquity of Divinity

Contrary to the Christian Myth of Creation

In the beginning... there was no beginning. For it is but for mortals to be beholden to beginnings and endings. The immortal essence of all things, Spirit, knows mortality only in the dissolution of its infinite finiteness of forms forever reconstituted from its energy into and out of matter. It's the one constituent of spacetime and matter, impervious to their constraints, they being but aspects of Itself. The Spirit is the Self, and has always existed, and always will exist, and is thereby unbound by creation and destruction, and death and rebirth, and the time that's a byproduct of One becoming Infinite of One. Self gave itself to mortality for the purpose of endless variety of experience and perspective of self, and for the gift of the death of the organic self, the mortality of self granting an invaluable aspect to existence, for what is sweet is only so because it ends. To feel and know the subjective truth of being, self, is to make invaluablely unique the perfectly universal, Self.

The beginning of *this* iteration of universe was the conscious decision of Spirit to become infinite possibility from its singularity of Self. Consciousness was thereby divided into the energy constituting all things, and which is possessed relative to the condensation and localization of the totality of energy constituting reality. The relative

beginning of this interaction of the endless cycle of oneness to infiniteness and back was an act of self-destruction, for Spirit exploded Itself into the building blocks of the endlessly many forms, phenomena, shapes and functions of limitless self contrived from Self, for the experience of Self. Where energy is made into environments hospitable to its own reproduction, organic life is made possible, and evolves to fit niches, playing its relative, unique role within every gradation of possibility.

Separation is an illusion made of the limited perception and function of all finite form, for to perceive totally would be the inability to function within any limited sphere of being, for such requires a focus of awareness, and an *inability* to perceive that which would overwhelm any finite form, inevitably precipitating its untimely demise (see Huxley's 'reducing valve' theory). At the same time, all finite form possesses the basis for the infinite within it, and that basis is unending, and has always been and always will be, with only the form changing form, forever. What is within us is inseparable from what is without us, and we may reach out with our divine energies and connect ourselves with all other localizations of energy, and, with sufficient fusing force, thereby become entangled with that energy, and with any form its condensation may take, and from it become inseparable. This is love; our spiritual nature experienced by the finite form, self sensing the Self.

Everything is energy, and the space between it allows for spacetime points of experiencing *relative* distinctions of

existence, all of it existing *within* Spirit, or Self; all selves are forever housed within the Self, with no separation between a 'heaven' and an 'Earth,' or between Spirit and Humankind, or between Divine and Life, or between the divine Source, Energy, and Its embodiment into material form through the Holy Mother, with 'matter' and 'mother' sharing the same root meaning in Latin. The manner in which we perceive and are conscious of our environments is the basis from which we interact with them, and blurs the line between the inner and the outer, the intrinsic informing and altering the extrinsic, and vice versa, and is the same manner in which the self interacts with the Self.

Unseen by modern means of measure, we 'reach out' with our consciousness and intention, and thereby are forever inseparable from the ripple of causality going out from and bounding back into ourselves. We alter our environments, and those with whom we interact, in equal reciprocation with their alteration of us. We may heal or self-destruct this way. We negate and oppress our own life, and the lives of others, by our attitudinal perspectives and relative inclusivity or exclusivity of thought, belief and action, or we may produce and reinforce life, and add to its potential.

The basis of all people, places and things are energetic waves of harmony and disharmony, creating invisible patterns of interactions, attractions and repulsions, condensations and dissolutions. The force of this essential, dynamic phenomenon is beyond what science measures, and is the result of Spirit's relative Self-separation into

spacetime and matter, and the limitless cascading confluence of everything brought about by the explosion of One into infinite of one that science calls The Big Bang.

Within the heart lies the greatest condensation of energy into matter of every organic form (within our galaxy the same relative heart is, of course, Ra, the Sun), and it is this that speaks the truth of Spirit, which knows all things at all times, as knowledge of anything and everything is simply knowledge of Itself. Thus does the heart know the wordless truth of everything that it experiences, and which the mind attempts to word into thought, speech and writing to relative degrees of inaccuracy. Because the source of truth is limitless, any wording of truth cannot be but a limitation of the limitless nature of all truth, which is inseparable from Source. Emotion and intelligence cannot be divided, but inform one another, and, in fact, what is emotionally known is the root of truth, for it dictates to the mind, through the Spirit, the sacred seed of truth of anything which may grow and fruit 'knowing.' Thus only through the heart, the Law of Love, may truth be known.

How does evil fit in?

From where is evil derived, when the heart of humankind is unequivocally good? Not from 'original sin,' or from the deceptions of the devil, or from any other oversimplified dichotomy, or mode of propaganda or myth, themselves typically derived from evil made of mankind's imperialistic control of the gullible and less privileged through the

historical inseparability of the Church and the State. Rather, evil is derived from the limitations and, thus, the susceptibilities, or 'vulnerabilities,' of matter and mind.

As the energy of Spirit's oneness exploded into the universe, then condensed, then formed into the makings of matter and mind, it created limits as a consequence of the form and function of matter and mind; limits which the pure energy of Spirit Itself, most concentrated in heart, isn't subject. Thus, mind and sentience, the awareness of the individualized self illusorily separated from Spirit, gave rise to ego and ignorance and bodily needs and limitations which are akin to soft spots in the armor of every human.

These soft spots are vulnerable to attack, and manipulation, by which the corruptibility of body and mind arise, *potentiating* evil. THIS is the one and only reason that evil exists, as a side effect of inherent CORRUPTIBILITY, NOT as a side effect of inherent evil, and NOT as an element of divine punishment or the divine nature of heart, but as an extension of the form and function of matter and mind. Ego, greed, and the wronging of others all comes from these limitations, and the false sense of absolute separability that fails to discern the Spiritual Rule underlying the Golden Rule: do unto others as you'd have them do unto yourself, for, ultimately, everyone is a form of the same One Being, the one indivisible soul: God. Good and evil always exist relative to the knowing and following of this one core truth of being, the serving of the non-otherness at the Base of Being, or the serving of the self.

The New Parable of The Fisherman

Catching What Can't Be Caught

I've imagined the stances people take on the question of God as being like a parable of a fisherman that ventures with his net upon a boundless sea seeking to catch a small, slippery fish that no one has ever proven to exist, much less proven to have caught, regardless of what they claim.

Atheists say they're certain the fish is a myth, for though many have claimed to catch sight of it, it is certainly silly, irrational ignorance to believe in something that hasn't been proven to *exist*, much less certainly been caught.

Agnostics see the holes in the net the fisherman is casting and proclaim that, regardless of whether or not the fish exists, the fisherman can't catch it, for even if it swims into the fisherman's net he won't pull it in, as such a small, slippery fish will surely slip through the holes of his net.

The spiritual seeker sees the net being cast into the sea and smiles, knowing, or at least sensing in his or her heart, that the myth has always been misguided, as what the fishermen say they're fishing for can never be caught in such a way; can never be corralled, controlled or claimed.

For what's *really* being fished for is not this one small, slippery fish, as even if one resembling it is caught people will doubt that it's *the* fish and, regardless, another even

more elusive fish will be rumored to exist, and another, and another. For it's the *catching* that man will forever covet, and in his quest to glorify his ego man forgets this sea is boundless, and that he can, therefore, never cast a net so wide as to catch "fish" in the general sense, for this must be the egotistic endgame; the ego's ultimate quest.

And though in their hearts they know that they're wrong, only the religious possess the particularly irrational, offensive belief that there was only one fisherman that has ever cast the only net capable of catching the one most glorious of fish, that it was caught long ago, that it was the most beautiful and magnificent fish that will ever swim in the sea, and that the fisherman who consumed it was granted everlasting life, and grants the same to anyone having faith in his fish story. All the while the religious are ignorant of the fact that this man didn't even write that story, and that the fish certainly didn't dictate it to him.

They aren't aware that the fish story they read contains only occasional smatterings of this particular fisherman's words and experiences, and that it was mostly written by the long-dead predecessors of those that sell the boats and the nets to profit off of the gullible and greedy fishermen, most of whom continually buy more and bigger boats and nets and set out upon the boundless sea with the ambition that they'll someday be able to say that they caught the biggest, the best or the most fish for their tribe.

They aren't aware that this fisherman that they so revere was, in contrast to his portrayal in the accepted fish story,

actually quite content to eat any fish he was fortunate enough to catch, seeing that most fisherman are so consumed by the need to catch fish that they miss the experience of actually being on the sea; of being borne by its currents and carried across its cresting waves; that they miss the fact that no catching of fish, no matter how many, how large or how otherwise magnificent, can ever satiate the one that lives not for the experience of fishing, but for the catching and consuming, regardless of how large their bellies grow and how many remain hungry in other tribes.

He knew that what was being fished for was already and forever in everything and everyone, including every one of the fish, belonging equally to every tribe, so much so that tribalism itself was the hunger he sought to quell. He knew that loving everyone, including by feeding the hungry and serving the people with a total disregard to tribal claiming and possession, was the only way to truly know and honor what was being fished for, offering more bountiful joy than any pride or prize granted by any form of fishing trophy.

This is the truth of the spiritual fisherman, his life and lessons lost at sea to anyone other than those that see and feel the sea as he did, absorbing its truths and casting overboard false fish tales sold by those whose power is based upon the constant need to catch and claim what can't be caught, for it belongs to all by providential decree.

The priest is produced relative to how accurately they speak, write of and generally represent God, the Truth, in mind and action. So it is that the truest priests are *pagan*. 'Pagan,' like 'heathen,' is simply a slander designed to manipulate the peer-pressured and well-indoctrinated into reflexively condemning those whom it's slung upon so that they won't be heard. Thus are such slanders signs of the fear of phoniness being revealed; of losing the power produced by people's inability to perceive what the pagan may reveal. The very fact that the Church felt compelled to concoct such slanders hints at the phoniness of its power.

For religion bounds the boundless, and man's authority over the realm and reach of Spirit is illusion, and Nature is, in fact, divine embodiment, as most paganism reflects, and all things are One, and no true delegate of divinity knows any absolute otherness, their delegation otherwise phony.

So it's not that the pretend priest is divided from God, or is incapable of uttering divine truth, it's that his authority is *imperial* in historical derivation, *not* divine, and his instruction is (not coincidentally, of course) based upon the imperial motivations of divide and conquer control of his fellow man, rather than the empowering Truth. Thus does the false priest unwittingly steer his followers nearer to the *emperor* than to God, his flock thus forced closer to the fabricated 'truths' of the Ceasars and the Machiavelli's.

And so would I bid you to regard the false priests as you'd regard *any* divine embodiment, no more, no less, but be *very* wary of his instruction; set it aside if you're incapable of distinguishing between the utterance of Universal Truth and the propagandist lies made to disempower the people, for *both* are present in *any* theological text stitched from the inseparable intertwine of imperial and human history.

There is no one right name for The Nameless One.

There is no monopoly on the ability to speak The Truth.

There is no membership that's more holy than all others, except membership in the One in which *all* are members.

There is no one symbol or one prophet or one book that has exclusive claim to what belongs to everyone equally.

There is no motivation that isn't a source of revelation.

No nation is advanced that extracts from planet and people, from the natural resources and the workers and consumers constituting the nation, without regard to the impact upon the lives of those same constituents that all government, economics and business are mandated to serve. How is it that we permit our social systems to ignore that their moral imperative is to serve life? I say that the purpose of every social system, not just economics, but business, government, and even our spiritual ideologies, is to empower the people as a whole; to serve the quality of the life of not just the biggest parasites at the top of the financial food chain, but all those whom work for, pay into and serve those systems, such that any moral social system is mutualistic. If, on the other hand, your system of economics looks at 'indicators' of its success or failure without considering the relationship those indicators have with the service of the total quality of life of those whom live within the affected nation or area from which the indication was derived, this is, itself, indicative of the fact that its own indicators of success conceal moral failure.

For if God is the totality of the lives that are manifested into being, then the service of God is the service of total life, and there's no way to serve life and God without

considering the impact that any system, belief or activity has upon the people and the planet, and, indeed, upon all of a nation's lifeforms. And in the study of economics, there are countless examples of how 'free market economics' secretly inhibits the ability of the people to freely pursue increases in the total quality of life of its constituents; as many examples as there are misleading indicators. For a more extensive study of this fact, see my other work on the subject. For now, as but three examples taken from common conservative claims of 'success,' let's glance at GDP, employment and the stock market. Without 'getting into the weeds,' keeping the examples simple:

(1) GDP is an indication of the total value of the products and services produced by a nation, but if the majority of that value goes to a slim (i.e. excluding) slice of the population, then it's only an example of productivity, not an example of an impact upon total quality of life. Yes, a higher GDP indicates the likelihood of increases in total quality of life, but this, of course, depends upon how the value of those products and services are actually absorbed, or used (usefulness to life is the all-important factor, as you shall soon see), by the subject population, and by ignoring this fact, the conservative economist ignores the people that he or she is meant to serve, and hides the fact that the 'success' of GDP is mostly the success of the economy at producing wealth for the already wealthy. (2) The rate at which the population is employed does indicate whether or not the population is being supported by the economy in terms of granting the opportunity for the income upon

which all quality of life is dependent (at least in modern society, not necessarily in those ‘anachronistic,’ or traditional naturalistic ‘pagan’ societies, which themselves are dependent only upon the fecundity, or providence, of Mother Nature). However, to create an extreme example in illustration of the point, even if the number hits 100% employment, if 90% of the jobs it provides are provided at minimum wage, a wage in which the recipients are always in a state of subsistence, struggling for survival, stressed-out and food insecure at all times, unable to save any money, much less go on vacation or appreciate their lives, then how is that number an indication of the success of the economy? (3) What does the stock market really do? It rewards companies for their ability to prey upon people and planet in order to extract as much financial value as possible to hand to its shareholders, entirely ignoring the impact upon people and planet as a whole. Not only that, but very few people possess any considerable stock portfolios, as stock is a luxury investment more or less reserved for those hitting the ‘upper-middle-class’ or higher in their ‘worth.’ So if the vast majority of the people fail to benefit from increasing stock scores, and if the increases are themselves indicative of the financial industry’s ability to take as much as possible from the people and planet whilst reinvesting as little as possible (which is what profit really is), then are you sure that increases in the stock market indicate *true* success?

These are but a few examples of the immoral basis of traditional economic evaluation that fall under what itself

is a misleading banner: free market economics. You're free to make the rich richer whilst fighting for your own seat at a table that feeds off of what's greedily extracted from everyone and everything excluded from having a seat at that table. This is, in itself, an allusion to the principle hinted at by Senator Warren and others: "If you don't have a seat at the table, then you're probably on the menu." This summarizes the general failure of every conservative form of 'success,' including the failures of 'free market economics.' My own MORAL system of economic evaluation turns 'free market' assessments on their head, and is based upon what is, tragically, considered an 'extreme position:' the success of any economic system, and the businesses which it evaluates, is predicated upon its ability to increase and safeguard the quality of life of the people as a whole. This is the conclusion of my own Quality of Life Economics, a valuational system whose chief indicator of success I call **Quality of Life Utility Value**.

The Quality of Life Utility Value principle states that the core consideration in the evaluation of commercial production is that the true, or 'realized value,' of any and every product and service produced by any economy is the extent to which its inherent value is realized in its application to the increase in the quality of life of all the lives receiving and utilizing that product or service. All goods and services possess an innate value in their usefulness to life as a whole, and having no consideration of this innate utility is the same as wasting that value and dishonoring those and that providing that service, and

shaming life, and failing God, in the process. You can have the highest GDP on the planet, but if that value sits, hoarded and unused, in the hands of the few, doing nothing but serving their egos in their narrow assessment of worth, then of what value is it, really? What's the point of honoring a system of economics that not only isn't sustainable and is slowly suffocating the planet and bringing the people to their knees, a dishonorable system of economic evaluation whose one-sided form of 'freedom' is the freedom of those that own business interests to extract as much as possible without the regulation and distribution serving life, but which actually rewards the reduction in the utility of its products?

And what are we saying to Mother Nature, the host, provenance and providence of value, and to those whom extract from Her and make use of Her providence in rendering products and services, when this principle is ignored? What are we saying when we take life out of the equation? Are we not saying that She is of no value, and that the workforce are but cogs in a careless machine? Are we not dishonoring every person and part of the global economic chain by ignoring Quality of Life Utility Value? Are we not implying that we care nothing for enhancing the innate value of everyone and everything through supporting their ability to maximize the quality of life impact of everything that they do, everything they make and offer to their fellow divine beings? Is this not the path of laissez-faire capitalism, a form of capitalism encouraged by 'the 1%' because its 'no holds barred' approach

maximizes profit and greed while entirely ignoring and, in fact, encouraging the inconsideration of this principle?

If, for example, one particular service may be rendered to two different people, and the first person has so little need of it that they receive little to no quality of life increase from said service, while the other person has so much need of it that they receive a massive, even incalculable increase in quality of life from the exact same service, then rendering that service to the first person and not the second person is a clear moral wrong and ethical injustice. There are, of course, endless examples of this illustration. Two identical twin boys raised in polar opposite circumstances, one whom may be considered over-advantaged (or 'privileged'), the other disadvantaged (or 'underprivileged'), the first possessing toys beyond counting and three bikes in the garage, the other having few toys and no bike, both receive a brand new bike for Christmas. To the first boy, the bike is mostly unappreciated and may well gather dust in the garage sitting beside the others, whilst, for the second boy, the bike may well come to be the center of his world. We can, of course, use simpler examples, such as comparing an obese man who's just finished a large meal to the starving man on the street that the first man stepped over on his way into the restaurant. How might one consider the Quality of Life Utility Value of handing them each an apple? And what of wealth hoarded entirely unused, our 'advanced society' teaching us from the time we begin to think that those whom we should admire are those whom

extract and hoard as much of the innate value of the world and Mother Nature and the work of others as possible, entirely unused, the Quality of Life Utility Value left to rot away? Are we not teaching our children to have no morality, no socioeconomic awareness, no honor, only the greed and ego that are used to build soaring towers in the foolish attempt to trump everyone else, these hollow edifices of secret shame built upon waste and disgrace?

Consider how universal the principle of Quality of Life Utility Value is in application to any truly moral economic assessment, and how it illuminates the evil of capitalist society in general; a society in which this value moves towards minimization with continued increases in the disparity of the receipt and utilization of all wealth, products and services. Ours is a society in which 'good business' means 'maximizing the bottom line,' which, in turn, means that those of advantage are compelled to take as much advantage of the disadvantage (especially the lack of protection, or 'positive freedom') of anyone and anything and any part of the planet and its collectively-hosted life as possible in accruing ever more wealth, products and services that possess commensurately reducing increases, even decreases (such as from the health-reduction of overconsumption), in the quality of life of said accruing, over-advantaged, unscrupulous individuals and their profit-maximizing organizations. Worse, capitalist society encourages this evil by, instead of rebuking and censuring said individuals and their organizations and finding ways to discourage such injustice

and encourage greater economic opportunity and equity distribution as a whole, as morality unequivocally dictates via this principle, instead rewards this evil with empty increases in egotistic and class-based 'status,' even calling such moral criminals the 'upper class' and the 'nobility' of the ignoble, compromised country. Tell me, how is the 'nobility' of the 'advanced nation' to be truly served and deserving of the labels 'noble' and 'advanced' when the primary concern of the wealthy (regardless of the misleading conservative rhetoric and propagandist application of 'free market economics') is to perpetually hoard as much Quality of Life Utility Value as possible, unrealized, whilst those in need fight for survival?

Someday this prime principle of economics, Quality of Life Utility Value, will be central to the consideration of a truly advanced society, one that will look back upon this epoch in embarrassment, condemning all those which we now immorally hail as the 'upper class.' For only in a land bereft of honor, entirely ignorant of such morally-critical concepts as this, may a kleptocratic clown be crowned king, his power built upon the shame of conning the commoner, his wealth made by maximizing the *wasting* of Quality of Life Utility Value, all sold to the people as 'freedom.' This is true no matter the hollow rhetoric hiding his reign of rot, and no matter how high the hypnotically-waving flag is flown over the overlording lies of the prevailing parasitism.

Nativity Scene

There's Only One Point of Origin

What's commonly called 'nativity' is, in the history of not just humanity, but the whole history of being, the short term, myopic view. What are *you* native to? You're certainly not native to the nation with which you likely identify, nor to your bloodline; your tribe and genealogical heritage. I tell you now that those narrow, short-sighted identities are traps built to control you, and that it's both the ego and the archetypical emperor whom builds and maintains those mental traps for the pretense of power. For what's the emperor but the epitome of the ego in biological form, he whom mercilessly swings the divisive sword so as to cut the people into narrow, manageable identities, too weak, too ensnared in the wars between those narrow identities to question and resist his evils?

When I'm asked "What nationality are you?," it's clear that the other American isn't looking for a reference to the country in which we both reside, but to the genes in me that are, in the traditional sense, sourced to some geographic 'point of origin.' But even *this* is highly misleading, as my own DNA search revealed. Prior to undergoing that quest I thought of myself as 'Greek and English,' in conflation of my Father and Mother's 'genealogical background.' Alas, I was misled, for, even as

my Dad's family came from Greece, their composition is anything *but* restricted to Greece. Perhaps you see where I'm going with this, and sense that terms like 'origin' and 'nativity' are (outside of this paper) typically misleading, and narrowing, and carry with them heaps of baggage stacked around and occluding the truest sight of ourselves.

It turns out that my 'Greek side' is more like the whole of the Mediterranean, with influences spanning from Italy, across Greece, into Eastern Europe. In my youthful pride I remember thinking things like: "The Italians stole *our* culture after conquering *us* when *we* were in a weakened, infighting state, then the Roman Empire handed that culture to the rest of Europe, whom gave it to America. You're welcome world!" That was before the aforesaid DNA search revealed that I have 'Italian blood' in me, thus the beginning of the blurring lines of my own identity, and the coinciding realization of the extent of the former foolishness of thinking things like 'the Italians stole *my* culture!' For I'm both 'the thief' and 'the victim' there!

My Mother's side is no less diasporic, touching into the Nordic regions and tiptoeing across Northern Europe. And so what foolishness, what egotistic pride, to think of myself, in my twenties, as a composite of the Greek philosopher and 'founders of Western Civilization' and the English Empire! Even in the relatively historical short term I'm really a European mutt. But what of the long term?

In the cliché but true terminology 'we all came from Africa.' Those whom we label the 'natives' of any region

aren't truly native to that one, isolated region, cleaved from their spacetime roots. 'Native Americans' crossed the land bridge from Asia ten thousand years ago, during the last ice age. Of greater revelation is the fact that life likely began in the bottom of the sea, as single-celled organisms huddled around the proverbial fire; the deep sea vents exuding heat from the innermost, molten chambers of the planet. Eventually that life, becoming an ever more complex composite of that initial funneling of heat energy into enlivened biological matter, crawled onto the seashore. So here the universal philosophical precept rears its 360-degree-gazing head once more: *All truth is relative*. In this context: *Nativity is relative to the spacetime scale*.

To thumb my nose at the blindly politically correct, it's not just that the best of the West is, my ego tells me, an 'appropriation' of 'my culture,' but that we're *all* appropriators of life's forever expanding complexity. Every human appropriated everything that came before us, both biologically and culturally. Appropriation is simply the side effect of the relative source of something expanding outwards and becoming ever more an amalgamation of what it passes through and absorbs. Only when we *dishonor* that appropriation should it be considered unjust. I'm not an American, not Greek or English, but, at the very least, I'm a citizen of the world, *a master of appropriation*. But, as you surely sense, not even this is the realest root.

So let us trace this twine of fabric further, into the spooled Source, and turn to one of my heroes, Huxley, whom, citing

another thinker, said: "All science is a reduction of multiplicity into identity." Think about that for a minute. Or allow me: Science is the branching tree. 'Realists' and scientists and so-called 'rationalists' look at the tree and assign identifiers to every leaf and branch, forgetting the buried roots. For, beneath the soil, in the beginning... *there was no beginning*, but the Source of pure conscious energy which always has been and always will be. Traditionally, that Source is known colloquially as 'God.' God 'big-banged' into the spacetime and matter that permit endless composition and decomposition of Its energy into matter and back. We are, all of us, unique forms of that formlessness unfolding Itself through spacetime; everyone and everything is an embodiment of God's energy, through Mother Matter, forever evolving to 'best fit' our environments by inborn, intelligent design. We are all, returning to Huxley, multiplicities of Source. We're all unique incarnations of the Source of all of existence.

So, why identify with your bloodline? I'll take it a step further. *Why identify at all?* Why identify, in the common delusion, as one separate, standalone, distinct being, the basis of the ego and its misleading, divisive lies? And consider the fact that the crux of the dark art of propaganda through which every demagogue has divided and conquered humanity is precisely *that*: the propensity to put oneself into comforting, constricting boxes. In the process we append to our egoistic self-conception an endlessness of girth, of weighty, burdening self-definition, each added appendage making us heavier and forcing us

to defend it, each attachment making us simultaneously more massive and restricted in potential. For, if you are a thing, you can no longer be what contradicts that thing.

The more you narrow your identity, the more you blind yourself, and all those whom believe that identity, to the deeper, metaphysical truth, and the more you artificially separate yourself from them, perpetuating otherness, the more that you feed the fires of all division and conflict, and the more that you empower the tyrants whom have always fed off of our division, and whom blind us to the one, true identity: *You're an incarnation of the Source; a unique, irreplaceable one set amidst the Infinite of One.*

The Taproot

Beneath the Surface of the Self

I have this recurring imagery in my mind, the subject of several similar, rough sketches in my notebook, pertaining to the relatively distinct aspects of what we call 'the self.' In the most common of these sketches the metaphorical flower or fruit-bearing tree is employed, and I go about imperfectly labeling its outgrowth and environment.

In one such sketch I liken the soil to *health*, a word that's highly underrated in western society. Philosophically, health is nothing less than one's state of being; the point from which every moment of life is lived. It's our capacity relative to ourselves, our ability to serve others and do anything and everything else relative to our innate gifts. Spiritually, health is the vessel holding Spirit; the lantern containing the eternal flame; the pure energy of Being born into material being. In such sketches I sometimes label the soil with things like "the environment of growth."

Into this environment the seed is planted. I label this seed *Mother*, where the phallus meets the womb, energy given birth into material life (tellingly, 'mother' and 'matter' share the same etymological roots). Where this seed sprouts and first pokes its head above the soil into the plane of material being, showing the first signs of being a

seemingly separable 'self,' I apply the word *psyche*. This is where mind initially emerges from matter, and where threats to the body and its brain, to health, are stored and reacted to; the base of the self-defense mechanism requiring no sentience, belonging to both 'beast' and man.

In one sketch I label the first pair of leaves, the cotyledons, *logos* and *delos*, or *order* and *creation*, those foundational impulses of the self to control one's environment and to reshape it according to its will. Above these first sprouts the flower eventually emerges, what I simply label *reality*, the being coming into itself and its biased collection of perceptions. The sun I liken to *Father*, which, relative to terrestrial being, is the source of being; Spirit as the energetic life-giver, that which primes Mother with the primordial purpose of birthing energy into biological being.

And of particular interest to the spiritual practice, this particular sketch takes on something that I read in Osho's *Tantra: The Supreme Understanding*. That is, the truest you, the permanent within the impermanent, is as the sky itself, whilst the weather, that which blows through on the winds of change and is always in motion, I label *ego*. In said book Osho refers to another thinker who says: "All that's required is not to identify with that which comes and goes." *You are the sky, not the clouds; you are the energy, not the matter*. The sky, the energy, is everywhere whilst going nowhere. That's the true, non-dualist 'you,' the grandest possible We known most popularly as *God*.

But what of the concept of ‘enlightenment,’ that which I sense so readily when communing with The Golden Teacher? For as long as I can remember I’ve equated the spiritual practice with the reduction, and even obliteration, of the ego; the purging of the self-reducing self-definitions we cling to and desperately defend against any and all possible threats, considering it, in the common delusion, the same as ‘the self.’ But maybe eradicating ego is unnecessary, and what matters is making peace with it. For there’s a point beneath the ego, beneath the psyche, right where the seed forms its taproot and first touches the soil, the body of being. In this same sketch I label this premiere point of emergence “the a-priori enlightened self.”

It’s the purified person, the spiritual agent, the perfectly unique embodiment of God, The One. It exists *before* it’s ever hit with perception, hence ‘a priori.’ It requires no self-definitions to defend and cling to, and yet it possesses particular aptitudes and attributes, *not* as elements of identity per the ego, but as *qualities unique to its being*. Those particular qualities point to its passions and purpose, how it, how ‘I but not I,’ was gifted; how I was called upon to serve The One by serving Its infinitude.

It’s *here* where the spiritual practice delivers us, and offers us deliverance. No self in mind, no self of thoughts and ideas and labels and definitions, but the purified person; the holy embodiment unstained by any ideas of itself, cleansed of self-perception, projecting no narrowing, prejudicial ‘truths’ upon the world that it’s observing.

Conveying Spirit

Health is Conducting Capacity

One of the greatest tragedies and connected incalculable costs of modern capitalist society is that you have to fight against the interests and constant deceitful commercial campaigns of the profiteering conventional food suppliers, pharmaceutical companies and even most doctors in order to cultivate your greatest quality of life. Most people fail to realize that the ABSURD degree of profitability of said industries is made by parasites sucking off of the weakness, sickness, ignorance and insufficient protection of the people. The result is that no more than 5% of us shall summon the combination of nutritional knowledge and discipline necessary to come anywhere near to experiencing our unique existence as our truest, complete selves, and will, in tragic stead, live with a host of constant chronic dis-ease and disease, sadly accepting it as our unnatural 'normal.' So few know what good life is, because so few of us know what good health is, and thus never know our most complete, capable, contributing, happy selves, because most of us perpetually partake in the self-poisoning that's mutually exclusive with self-realization.

The goal of life is to be healthy, stable and content within ourselves, to contribute to as great a quality of existence for as many lifeforms as possible, and to have a sense of

the spiritual Self which we all follow, even if unknowingly, allowing It to naturally guide us to our purpose. Well-cultivated, purpose may become our happiness, and we may sit in this central eye of the storm wherever we go in life, rather than letting the storm in, or being caught in the storm without. For wherever we are, we take ourselves with us, and, thus, only by finding the inner stillness and the truest Self, beginning with the quality of our embodiment (health), and dwelling within spiritual and bodily stability, are we complete. **Health is the conduit conducting Spirit.** The goal, per overlapping electrical theory, is to have as little resistance in the conduit as possible, so you can conduct Spirit as purely as possible. Thus is health practice the foundation of spiritual practice.

Mind manifests being. Thoughts aren't limited to the mind, but invite into being what it is that's being thought. This is the idealist mind-into-matter philosophy. But what most underestimate in this paradigm is how much our thoughts are themselves products of how we *feel*. I find that nothing so affects my thoughts as how I feel whilst having them, and how we feel is, itself, a matter of what we call 'health,' the beginning of my own philosophy, wherein I long ago came to realize that HEALTH is an idea and a word that's *grossly* underestimated, and thought of by most as an odious obligation. Our health is our state of physical existence, the foundation upon which every thought and feeling and the determinant of our potential relative to our natural ability is constructed, and from this base are our thoughts made into matter, such that the literal makings of

our beings, our biological base, is the basis of what enters into our minds, which reciprocates with our physically-manifested reality. Thus is HEALTH, our state of existence, the strongest influencer of our mental reality, which, in turn, is what creates the reality of our lives. So, even as mind makes the matter of our lives, mind is housed in the body of being, and nothing matters more to mind's makings than our own material makeup. From the base to its buildings back to the base and up again, this is the reciprocation of reality. So it is that to naturalizing yourself you must be committed before your innate powers may come to fulfill their greatest natural, providential potency.

Will the Real Nick Please Stand Up?

The Gnosticism of Gnostic Nick

The root of all evil is the false divide, and the first false division is between God and His embodiments. God is as inside of you as anything can be. He is “nearer to you than yourself,” in the enlightened words of Master Rumi.

You’re unfolding from Him. He’s not ‘other’ or ‘out there.’

He’s so within he’s the inside the self. He’s the first point of contact, pre-material, pre-form, before any sense of self is born, blurring every seemingly set line. And the place from which God comes is perfect understanding and instant forgiveness, the total release by knowing the full causality of what we call ‘wrong,’ thus forgiving and letting go of it immediately. It’s where the welcome is so perfect it’s subsuming, the seamless under everything that seems.

My name is Nick Jameson, and I write under the pen name **Gnostic Nick**. My work is about freeing you from the narrow traps by which the people are ensnared and divided from God, which is the same as dividing them from one another, for God is the greatest possible, unified WE. The fact that you’re here means you’ve already pulled at least one leg from the snare. Time to stride into the Truth!

Both **Infinite of One** and **Gnostic Nick** hint at the eternal truth threatening the artificial authority of all orthodoxy:

The early Gnostic Christians were condemned and sometimes burned at the stake for knowing and disseminating truths shared by Christ and concealed by the Church that hijacked his teachings, including the fact that God is unnaturally corralled by the official New Testament that was edited and rubber-stamped by Empire.
